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### MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

#### MUNICIPALITY OF KANDY.

**N**OTICE is hereby given that the Chairman of the Municipal Council of Kandy will receive sealed tenders for the purchase of the under-mentioned Toll Rents of the Central Province from January 1, 1912, to December 31, 1912: The tenders, which must be in sealed envelopes superscribed "Tender for Toll Rents," will be received at the Municipal Office until 8 A.M. on Saturday, September 16, 1911, when they will be opened, and all persons making tenders will be required to be present, and tender must be delivered in person.

2. The person whose tender is selected by the Chairman for submission to the Council will be required to deposit at once one-tenth of the purchase amount in cash; and should the tender be accepted by the Council, to furnish approved security for one-half of the whole purchase amount, or in cash for one-third of the whole purchase amount, within thirty days of the date of the receipt by him of the notification of the Council's acceptance of his offer. If deeds are tendered as security, the one-tenth cash deposit will be retained till the rent is closed.

3. He will also be required to deposit money to pay the fees of Counsel for examining and giving his opinion on the title deeds of properties tendered by him as security, and for examining and settling the security bond, and the fees charged by the Council's proctor for examining documents and drawing the security bond, and also the expenses of appraising the properties and of registering the security bond.

4. All title deeds tendered as security should be accompanied by a certificate obtained from the Registrar of Lands that the lands to which they relate are unencumbered. This certificate must be obtained at the cost of the party offering the security.

5. The renter shall be bound to provide and maintain, at his own expense, sufficient boats and boats' crew at the said ferry, the seaworthiness of the boats, and the number of the crew being subject to the approval of the Chairman, Municipal Council.

6. Further information regarding conditions of sale can be obtained on application to the Secretary, Municipal Council.

## MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

## Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held in the Municipal Office on Saturday, July 8, 1911.

The Council met this day at 2 P.M., pursuant to notice dated July 3, 1911.

*Present*:—Mr. C. M. Lushington, Chairman; Mr. D. G. Goonawardena; Mr. H. F. Tomalin; Mr. F. Perera; Mr. S. H. Titley; Dr. C. B. Lourensz; and Mr. C. E. de Vos.

The Minutes of the General Meeting of the Council held on June 10, 1911, a copy of which was sent to each Member, were taken as read.

Resolved that the Minutes of the General Meeting of Council held on June 10, 1911, be confirmed.

1. Before proceeding with the business laid down in the agenda paper the Chairman, with the permission of Council, welcomed Mr. C. E. de Vos to the Council. He then referred to the manner in which the address of this Council to His Most Gracious Majesty King George V. was presented. He said that the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, in reply to inquiries as to how the address was to be presented, had advised that the address may either be sent up or presented personally to His Excellency the Governor in the Council Chamber with other public bodies after the Special Meeting of the Legislative Council, but as he as Government Agent would be unable to leave Galle on that day, it might be better that the Municipal Council should present their address to the Government Agent as part of the ceremonies to be held at Galle, but that in making these suggestions Government did not wish to in any way fetter the discretion of the Municipal Council in the matter.

These suggestions were referred to the Members during his absence, and on his return he found that the majority of the Members had intimated their desire that the address should be forwarded to His Excellency the Governor.

He regretted that the Members did not choose to adopt the suggestion that the address should be presented to the Government Agent as part of the ceremonies held at Galle, and without in any way disturbing the harmony which exists in this Council he wished to entirely disassociate himself with the manner in which the address was presented.

2. Papers *re* widening of Lighthouse street by the acquisition of the verandahs of Nos. 1 and 2, Lighthouse street, Fort.

Resolved that Mr. Macan Markar be informed, with regard to the suggestion contained in his letter dated May 24, 1911, that the Council may have a portion of the front verandah of house No. 2, Lighthouse street, in exchange for the land recently purchased by the Council—next to the house occupied by the Rev. Mr. Burrows (and more correctly specified in R. P. No. 2,592), in extent 6.81 perches—and that the roof of the verandah not required be properly be restored and guttering, &c., provided by the Council; that the Council is prepared to give him so much of the Council's land referred to, which will make the boundary of the premises occupied by the Rev. Mr. Burrows more regular than it is at present, and also restore the roof of the verandah as desired.

3. The Hon. the Colonial Secretary's letter No. 15, dated July 3, 1911, *re* extension of Police limits so as to include an area within three chains of certain roads forming the boundaries of the present limits.

The Chairman moved (1) that the Government Agent be requested to be so good as to cause the new area to be assessed by his headmen and inform this Council the cost of the work; (2) that the assessment, lighting, and water-rate be levied from this area commencing from October 1, 1911. Mr. D. G. Goonawardena seconded.—Carried.

4. Papers referring to the proposal to levy rates and taxes on all lands, buildings, and tenements outside the Police limits.—Deferred for next Meeting.

*The Vibrocel Co., Ltd.*—"A new or improved method of and means for the construction of concrete sea-walls, piers, pontoons, floating-stages, foundations, and other structures."

*Abstract.*—This invention is a method of constructing reinforced vibrated concrete structures consisting in, forming a base portion, cementing reinforced concrete pillars thereon, intermeshing the metallic reinforcement of contiguous pillars, embedding said reinforcement in concrete walls in such a manner as to connect those pillars to form a tier of hexagonal cells similar in size, erecting another tier or other tiers of vertical pillars upon those first described, intermeshing the metallic fabric of adjacent pillars and the metallic fabric of the superposed tier with the metallic fabric of the tier below, and so incorporating and interknitting the hexagonal cells as to form a section or unit which may be floated to the site where the structure is to be deposited to form a sea-wall or pier. Special means are provided also for fracturing, by an explosive, the bottoms of some or all of the cells to sink the structure when required.
