Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 18 of 1911.

An Ordinance further to amend "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898."

HUGH CLIFFORD.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the provisions of "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898," with reference to the commutation of sentences: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Criminal Procedure Code (Amendment) Ordinance, 1911."

New section 329.

2 Section 329 of "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898," is hereby repealed, and the following is hereby substituted in lieu thereof:

The Governor may, without the consent of the person sentenced, commute any one of the following sentences for any of the commuted sentences indicated :

Sentence.	Commuted Sentence.
Death	Rigorous or simple imprisonment for life or for any other term.
Rigorous imprisonment	Any lesser term of rigorous imprisonment, or any term of simple imprisonment not exceeding the term to which such person might have been sentenced, or fine.
Simple imprisonment	Any lesser term of simple imprisonment or fine.
