
And whereas Dissanayake Mudiyanselage, Heen Banda made claim thereto, and I, John George Fraser, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim, and whereas the said claimant and I, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, came to an agreement in writing dated January 4, 1910, concerning the said land, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the said claimant should be declared the purchaser of the said land upon payment on or before March 4, 1910, to the Government Agent at Badulla, of a sum of Five Rupees (Rs. 5) only, as the purchase amount of the said land, and whereas the said amount has been duly paid by the said claimant, he is hereby, in pursuance of the agreement afore-mentioned, declared to be the purchaser of the said land, as more fully described herein below.

Description of the Land referred to.

The land commonly called or known as Hewanillehena, situated in the village of Welgolla, in the Bogoda korale of the Yatikinda division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent 3 roods and 36 perches, shown as lot 16l in preliminary plan 175, and in the annexed diagram, and bounded as follows: on the north by Hewanile claimed by D. M. Punchirals and others, Hewanillehena sold by the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances to Dissanayake Mudiyanselage Mutu Banda; on the east by the Welgollekandura; on the south by the Welgollakandura, Hewanillehena sold by the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances to Dissanayake Mudiyanselage Ukku Banda; on the west by Hewanillehena sold under the Waste Lands Ordinances to D. M. Ukku Banda, Hewanille claimed by D. M. Punchirala and others.
