MINUTE BY THE GOVERNOR.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR desires to express his sincere regret at the death of Mr. HENRY LORENZ WENDT, late Puisne Justice of the Supreme Court.

The late Mr. Wendt represented the Burgher Community in the Legislative Council for some years, and had also acted as Attorney-General of this Colony before he was appointed a Puisne Justice of the Supreme Court in October, 1901. His high character and integrity and his profound knowledge of local laws and customs made him a valued servant of the Crown, and his retirement last year at a comparatively early age owing to failing health was much regretted.
