150 (more or less) cyclone blown down, top broken, and damaged trees in the forest called Velankrikadu at Devilane, in the Maha-oya range, Batticaloa District, and bounded on the north by Pavaru, on the south by Unagalatalawa, on the east by Hammangala-ela, and on the west by Vellankri.

100 (more or less) cyclone blown down, top broken, and damaged tumpalai trees in the forest called Thalayadimaduchenai, in the Maha-oya range, Batticaloa District, and bounded on the north by Puluganawa service road, on the south by Kachchakadipoval, on the east by Athuchenai-kadu, and on the west by Puluganawa-Devilane road.

2. Offers must be made for each of the two lots in one lump sum, and on forms supplied by the Assistant Conservator of Forests on a deposit of Rs. 20 being made.

3. The highest offer is subject to the approval of the Conservator of Forests.

4. Half the value of the timber must be paid for within 15 days of the acceptance of the offer by the Conservator of Forests on issue of felling license, and the balance before the issue of a removal permit. Default herein will involve forfeiture of the deposit mentioned in clause 2.

5. The timber in each lot must be felled and removed from the forest within four months from the date of payment, and the timber not so removed will revert to the Crown.

6. Intending purchasers are particularly advised to see the timber before making their offers.

7. Further particulars can be had on application to the Assistant Conservator of Forests, Batticaloa.

8. The Government reserves to itself the right, without question, of rejecting any or all offers, and the right of accepting any portion of an offer.
