# SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER, 1911.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy: the paddy plants of the maha season are blossoming. Yala harvest nil.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: the flowering prospects of coconuts are not very satisfactory. The average price of coconuts varies from Rs. 60 to Rs. 70 per 1,000 nuts. Fruits, such as pineapples and mangoes, are very scarce; oranges and jak are procurable.

Staple products: a bushel of imported rice is sold from Rs. 4 to Rs. 6. Rainfall: there had been several good showers of rain during the month.

Harvest prospects: generally good.

Health of people: enteric fever, measles, chickenpox, and dysentery are on the increase.

Health of cattle: rinderpest prevailed in Hewagam korale to a very large extent. The disease is on the decrease now.

#### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is thriving well.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: (a) the supply of vegetables and dessert fruits was scanty; (b) the flowering of coconuts was good. The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 3,159,500 nuts.

Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 80 per 1,000 nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: nothing can be said at present of the coming harvest.

Health of people: satisfactory, except for a few cases of dysentery, chickenpox, measles, and contagious fever mostly in the totamunes.

Two tanks in Metkumulai pattu are reported to have breached. Tobacco: gardens are being manured. Coconuts: flowering is just commencing after the drought. Palmyras: nil. Dry grains: in ear. The chenas have been damaged by rain and caterpillars.

Health of people: the inevitable outbreak of malarial fever of a severe type in consequence of the floods has

commenced.

Health of cattle: normal.

Prices of food stuffs: rice, Rs. 5.50 per bushel; paddy, Rs. 2 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 8.50 per 100.

MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

Paddy-kalapokam cultivation: dry sowing is in ear, and mud sowing partly in ear and partly in young stage. Many tanks have breached during the recent heavy rains, and cultivation under some of them may fail for want of water.

Dry grain: kurakkan in chenas are in ear. The prospects of the crop in Vavuniya North is unsatisfactory owing to the heavy rains.

Other products—coconuts: the trees have been flowering well. The estimated crop for the month was 102,975 nuts. Prices of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 per bushel; paddy, Rs. 2·25 per bushel; kurakkan, Rs. 2 per bushel; ellu,

Rs. 8 per bushel; kollu, Rs. 4 per bushel.

Rainfall: there has been an unusually heavy rainfall throughout the district during the month, and many houses and compounds and roads were flooded and many tanks breached.

Harvest prospects: doubtful.

Health of inhabitants: unsatisfactory. Fever was prevalent almost in all villages.

Health of cattle: good. Rinderpest was prevalent in Vavuniya South.

# SOUTHERN PROVINCE, '

GALLE DISTRICT.

Maha crop is thriving.

The cultivation of dry grain is restricted.

Coconut, tea, cinnamon, and vegetables are general products. The prospects of coming crops of coconut are good. The estimated crop for the month is 3,001,087.
