AGREEMENT OF LEASE.

An agreement entered into the ———— day of ————, between ————, Government Agent of the Western
Province, for and on behalf of Our Sovereign Lord the King (hereinafter called the lessor, which expression shall include
his successors in office for the time being), of the one part, and, of (hereinafter called the lessee, which
expression shall include his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns), of the other part, by which the parties hereto
agree as follows:—

- The lessor on behalf of the Crown agrees to let and demise and the lessee to take all that allotment of Crown land, -, particularized in the schedule hereto, and containing in the whole -— in with all ways, waters, easements, and appurtenances thereto belonging or usually occupied or enjoyed therewith, for the -, of which one-tenth - years from the . - day of --- for the gross sum of Rupees — portion, to wit, Rupees lessee to the lessor by equal quarterly payments on the --, the - day of - day of ~ in every year of the said term, the first of such quarterly next, and the last to be made in advance one calendar month before - day of ---—, and the -- day of payments to be made on the day of the expiration of the said term.
- 2. The lessee shall not during the term aforesaid sublet or lease any portion of the said plantation or premises, and shall not erect or construct any temporary or permanent buildings upon the said premises or open any road through the premises, except with the previous consent in writing of the lessor.
