RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the crop on fields cultivated for the maha harvest is being gathered in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Atakalan korales; prospects favourable. In Kukul and Kolonna korales the plants are about four months old. In Meda and Kadawata korales the plants are dying for want of rain.

Dry grain: the crop on chenas is being reaped and gathered; prospects favourable.
