Special rates will be charged for ebony, calamander, teak, margosa, and suriya, also for sawn bulks of timber, for all timber in the log exceeding 25 feet in length, and for all sawn timber any side of which exceeds 12 inches, delivered at any depôt.

Round poles and warichchies will not be kept on stock at the depôts.

Persons splitting shingles on Crown forest on permit must pay royalty on the whole of the trunk of any tree felled.

Persons burning charcoal on Crown forest on permit must pay at firewood rates for all the wood cut.

Charcoal will be issued from depôts only in quantities of five, ten, fifteen, &c., cut bushels.

Permits to cut mâna and illuk grass on Crown land for a period of six months will be issued to managers of estates on payment of Rs. 2.50 as royalty.

The full royalty due, or if it cannot be accurately calculated the estimated amount, must be paid before any permit is issued.

## DRAFT ORDINANCES.

### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to empower the Trustees of the Church of St. Paul to alienate a portion of Land belonging to the said Church.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Right Reverend Reginald Copleston, Doctor of Divinity, Lord Bishop of Colombo; the Hon. Sir Edward Noel Walker, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Colonial Secretary; and the Hon. Augustine Rawlins Dawson, Government Agent of the Western Province, are the trustees of the Episcopal Church situated in St. Paul's road, Colombo, and commonly known as the Church of St. Paul :

And whereas the said church and surrounding ground belonging thereto are vested in the said Bishop of Colombo, Colonial Secretary, and Government Agent of the Western Province, and their successors in office as trustees of the said church :

And whereas a portion of land surrounding the said church is required by the municipality of Colombo for the improvement and alteration of the roads and drains near the said church, and it is necessary and expedient that the trustees aforesaid should be empowered to transfer to the said municipality a portion of the said ground: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Trustees empowered to sell or exchange a portion of land belonging to St. Paul's church, Colombo.

1 It shall be lawful for the Bishop of Colombo, the Hon. the Colonial Secretary, and the Hon. the Government Agent of the Western Province, as trustees of the said church of St. Paul, Colombo, or their successors as such trustees, by writing under their hands or under the hands of any two of them, of which two the Bishop of Colombo shall be one, to transfer to the municipality of Colombo, either by sale or exchange, any portion of the land surrounding the said church as to such trustees may seem fit, and to apply to the purposes of their trust, and to no other purpose, any land, money, or other property which may come into their hands as the proceeds of such sale or exchange.

Short title.

2 This Ordinance may be cited as "The St. Paul's Church Ordinance, 189 ."

And whereas by section 3 of the said Ordinance it is further enacted that, if within the period specified in such notice as aforesaid a claim shall be made, the Government Agent shall call upon the claimant to establish the same within such time as the Government Agent shall appoint, and shall inquire into such claim, and record all such evidence as may be adduced before him in support thereof; and further that the Government Agent shall thereafter make a report to the Governor of the proceedings taken by him, which report shall contain a description of the land, with the boundaries thereof, and shall set forth the nature of the claim made in respect thereof, the evidence taken in support of such claim, and the finding of the Government Agent thereon:

And whereas by section 4 of the said Ordinance it is further enacted that if the Governor in Executive Council shall, upon such report as aforesaid, or after such further inquiry as he may deem expedient, be satisfied that a *prima facie* right to the said land has been established, all further proceedings under the said Ordinance in respect of such land shall cease; but if the Governor in Executive Council shall entertain any doubt as to such right, the Governor shall refer the claim to the District Court of the district in which the land is situate; and the Judge of such court shall thereupon fix a day for the investigation of the claim with notice thereof to the claimant and to the Attorney-General, and after hearing such evidence as the claimant or Attorney-General shall adduce, or the court may call for, the said Judge shall decide whether in his opinion such right has or has not been established, and shall make such order as to costs as he shall deem just. Every such decision, however, shall be subject to an appeal, free from stamp duty, to the Supreme Court, by the Attorney-General or by such claimant, and such appeal shall be subject to the same rules which govern interlocutory appeals from District Courts:

And whereas by section 5 of the said Ordinance it is further enacted that if the decision of the District Judge, or of the Supreme Court in the event of an appeal, shall be that such right has been established, all further proceedings in respect of such land under the said Ordinance shall cease; but if such decision shall be that such right has not been made out by the claimant, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council to make order that the land shall be resumed by the Crown, and the same shall thereupon be vested in and become the property of the Crown free from all encumbrances.

And whereas under and in pursuance of the said enactment a notice was duly published in the said English, Sinhalese, and Tamil languages in the *Gazette* on October 3, 10, 17, 24, and 31, and November 7, 1890, respectively, and in the *Ceylon Observer* and *Ceylon Independent*, that an allotment of land lot No. 2,136½ in preliminary plan 214, containing in extent 4 acres 2 roods and 34 perches, known as Bulatwellamulahena, situate in the village Mipitiya in Ihalawisideka koralé of the Weudawiti hatpattu, in the North-Western Province of the Island of Ceylon, and described in title plan 83,384; bounded on the north and north-east by land said to belong to the Crown, south-east by Ratgorakaghahena-ela, south-west by land described in title plan 83,388, and north-west by land described in title plan 83,387, which had been alienated by the Crown, appeared to the Government Agent of the North-Western Province to have been so abandoned by the owner thereof for eight years and upwards as aforesaid; and the said Government Agent, by virtue of the powers vested in him by the said Ordinance, and with the sanction of the Governor thereby, declared that if no claim to the said land by any person having a right or able to establish a title thereto was made to him on or before December 31, 1891, the same should be resumed by the Crown in pursuance of the said Ordinance, and the said notice was duly posted on the said land as by the said Ordinance required:

And whereas in obedience to the said notice a claimant, to wit, Muna Raman Chetty, as attorney of Periya Karuppan Chetty of Natchchantu Vaddi in India, did appear, and his claim was by the Governor considered doubtful, and reference was therefore made to the District Court of Kurunegala in terms of the 4th section of the said Ordinance, and the decision of the said District Judge is that such right has not been made out by the said claimant, and the said claimant has not appealed against this decision:

Now know all Men that We, Sir Edward Noel Walker, Knight Commander of the most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor in and over the Island of Ceylon with the Dependencies thereof, in Our Executive Council, acting in pursuance and by virtue of the powers vested in Us by the 5th section of the said Ordinance, did on the 15th day of June, 1893, make order that the said land so described as aforesaid should be resumed by the Crown, and the same was hereby resumed by and became the property of the Crown free from all encumbrances.

### ABSTRACT OF SEASON REPORTS FOR JUNE, 1893.

#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

*Paddy.*—In the low-lying parts of the district, the yala paddy plants have been to some extent damaged by floods; elsewhere they have continued in a thriving condition. In Héwágam korale a good muttes crop has been reaped. In Siyané korale East and West fields are being prepared for cultivation for the maha harvest.

##### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

*Paddy.*—The prospect for the yala harvest seems to be good. Some damage has been done by highwater to the low-lying fields, but the plants generally are doing well. A good crop is expected.

##### NEGOMBO DISTRICT.

*Paddy.*—Crop prospects middling. Yala cultivation somewhat damaged by rain in Alutkuru korale, and by bambupiduma in Hapitigam korale.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

##### KANDY DISTRICT.

*Paddy and Dry Grain.*—Yatinuwara, Udunuwara, and Harispattu : paddy, yala being transplanted, maha being ploughed ; kurakkan growing well ; both good prospects. Uda Dumbara and Pata Dumbara : yala, paddy, and kurakkan in various stages ; poor prospects owing to drought ; some maha fields being threshed. Pata Héwáheta : paddy, yala sowing over ; prospects good. Udapalata and Uda Bulatgama : paddy, maha being ploughed, yala growing ; good prospects.

##### MÁTALÉ DISTRICT.

Rainfall very poor, particularly in Mátalé North. Cultivation for yala begun only in a few places with the aid of stream water.

##### NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

*Paddy and Dry Grain.*—Kotmalé : paddy cultivation for the maha commenced. Chenas sown with kurakkan. Uda Héwáheta and Walapané : reaping of the maha harvest continued ; fair crop. No work on chenas.

#### NORTHERN PROVINCE.

##### JAFNA DISTRICT.

*Dry Grain.*—Panichamy, umichamy, and kurakkan in good condition. Cutting and curing of tobacco continued.

*Weather.*—Cloudy during first three weeks. Some showers on 7th, 8th, and 9th in four divisions. Wind in general from south-west

##### MANNÁR DISTRICT.

*Paddy and Dry Grain.*—No land now under crop. The south-west rains have failed completely. Relief works opened on mainland. Chenas in Mannár island cleared for dry grain.

##### MULLAITTÍVU DISTRICT.

Slight rains at beginning of month. Manuring and ploughing fields in maritime pattus. Colds and fever prevalent. Scarcity in Karunaval pattu and Tunukkai. Relief work commenced in Karunaval pattu.

##### VAVUNIYA DISTRICT.

No cultivation in the district except under Mainadu. Relief work going on in seven divisions.

#### SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

##### GALLE DISTRICT.

*Paddy.*—Crop good in the Four Gravets and Akmimana, Wellaboda pattu, and Hinidum pattu ; middling in Talpe pattu and Bentota-Walalláwiti kóralé ; and bad in Gangaboda pattu owing to damage caused by floods.

##### MÁTARA DISTRICT.

*Paddy and Fine Grain.*—Morawak kóralé : paddy fair ; fine grain good. Gangaboda pattu : paddy in ear damaged by rain ; fine grain fair. Wellaboda pattu : paddy partly damaged by rain ; fine grain good. Kandaboda pattu : paddy and fine grain fair. Four Gravets : paddy partly damaged by rain. Weligam kóralé : paddy badly damaged by rain ; fine grain good.

##### HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

*Paddy and Fine Grain.*—Crop prospects very favourable throughout the district. Cultivation under all the irrigation works extensive, and very promising.

#### EASTERN PROVINCE.

##### BATICALOA DISTRICT.

Early pinmari crops on 2,000 acres is very good, and is being harvested ; sowing of late pinmari on 5,500 acres nearly over. Crop in good condition.

##### TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT.

Pinmari crops in progress, and vary from blossom to grain at Tampalakam. Paddy plants here and there are attacked with leaf disease.

## NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

## KURUNÉGALA DISTRICT.

*Paddy and Dry Grain.*—Hiriyala hatpattu: paddy and dry grain partially withered owing to drought; some dry grain crops reaped; rain insufficient. Dambadeniya hatpattu: yala paddy and dry grain thriving; ploughing for maha begun. Wannu hatpattu: dry grain crops partially reaped; withered in four of the korales; rain insufficient; distress threatens. Weudawili hatpattu: crops fair; 600 acres paddy and 200 acres chena cultivated during this month. Dewamedu hatpattu: prospects bad. Katugampola hatpattu: small extent of paddy cultivated for yala, but prospects good; maha cultivation begun; kurakkan and mun maturing; meneri crop tolerable.

## CHILAW DISTRICT.

*Paddy and Dry Grain.*—Northern division: fields cultivated with bala-wi in most villages, but on a small scale only; recent rains did good, but insufficient water in tanks. In Central and Southern divisions: about 1,030 bushels paddy and 184 bushels fine grain sown; weather favourable, and plants thriving well; prospects good.

## PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

*Paddy and Fine Grain.*—Paddy crop young and fair; fine grain middling and poor.

## NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

*Paddy and Fine Grain.*—The monsoon has practically failed; registered rainfall for June 5.8 inches, and of the whole quarter 5.3 inches only; with few exceptions the tanks are nearly empty. Paddy crops of different stage: some maturing, some blossoming, and some still young, but from want of rain the cultivation is limited. No chena cultivation. To prevent distress chena permits will be issued for maha harvest, and cultivation will commence in July. Murrain in Kadawat and Ulagalla korales.

## PROVINCE OF UVA.

*Paddy and Dry Grain.*—Harvesting general throughout the Province. Crops middling; reported damage by flies in Wellassa and Wellawaya; better results expected from later crops. A commencement of chena clearing has been made.

## PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

## RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

*Paddy.*—The yala fields throughout the district have been sown; prospects good owing to the favourable rain, but in Atakalan and Kolonna korales some fields have been damaged by heavy rain and flood. The cultivation for the first mahá in Nawadun korale has been delayed owing to excessive rain floods and disease among people.

*Dry Grain* on chenas and owita land promise a good crop in Kolonna koralé. Maha chenas for 1894 are being cleared.

## KÉGALLA DISTRICT.

*Paddy.*—Yala prospects Beligal koralé not satisfactory owing to halpanpiduma; Paranakuru koralé and Galboda and Kinigoda koralés fair; Three Koralés and Lower Bulatgama good. Ploughing for maha in progress throughout the district.

*Hill Paddy* is being sown in parts of Paranakuru koralé and Beligal koralé; prospects fair. Kurakkan: Galboda and Kinigoda koralés and Paranakuru koralé, prospects fair; Beligal koralé, Three Koralés, and Lower Bulatgama, good. Mun prospects good in Galboda and Kinigoda koralés and Beligal koralé. Gingelly prospects good in Beligal koralé.

*Health.*—Foot and mouth disease has broken out at the end of the month in a group of villages lying in the Three Koralés and Beligal koralé. There is no murrain. Fever is still prevalent in all parts of the district. The general health of the district is exceptionally bad. There are no cases reported of serious infectious diseases.

*Talawatuhenpita.*—North by Madugahawatta belonging to Thomas Caberal and the private lands alongside the road up to Millegahawatta belonging to Ranasinha Kankanamalage Sarohami, east by the cart road leading to the Government burial ground called Millegahawatta, south by Maragahawatta belonging to Lorenzu Lewis and the private lands alongside the road up to Gorakagahawatta belonging to Wanasinha Arachchige Pedris, and on the west by the village boundary of Talawatuhenpita South.

*Henaratgoda on the Kandy Road.*—North by the village boundary of Henaratgoda, east by private lands alongside the Kandy road and Government drain, south by the village boundary of Mudungoda, and west by private lands alongside and the resthouse premises.

THE following by-laws made by the Board of Health for the North-Central Province, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 5 of "The Nuisance Ordinance, 1862," have been submitted to and confirmed by the Governor and the Executive Council, and they are hereby published for general information.

*By-laws referred to.*

1. The constables, kórálas, gay-árachchies, vidi-árachchies, or other headmen, as the case may be, shall, on the appearance of any case or suspected case of smallpox or cholera in their divisions, report the occurrence with the least possible delay to the kachehéri and the local medical officer; and every male adult, or, in the absence of any male adult, every female adult inmate shall in like manner forthwith report to the nearest constable or local headman the occurrence of such case or suspected case in the household: Provided that the report by one such adult shall be sufficient.

2. Any person found beyond his or her compound, and suffering from smallpox or cholera, shall be immediately removed by the local headmen to the nearest temporary smallpox or cholera hospital, if there be one within five miles; and if there be none, then such person shall be kept in some sufficient temporary accommodation to be provided for him or her by the nearest headman, who shall engage a competent attendant and provide sustenance and other necessities for the patient, reporting immediately his having done so to the kachehéri and the local medical officer.

3. In the case of application to that effect being made by the owner or occupier of a house, or head of a family, or person affected, the constable or local headman shall remove or place in temporary shelter, in the manner specified in by-law 2, any member of a family infected with smallpox or cholera, and engage an attendant or two, if necessary, reporting his having done so forthwith to the kachehéri and the medical officer, and supply sustenance and other necessities. Provided, however, that it shall be lawful for the medical officer to dispense with such removal if he deem it desirable and consistent with the safety of the other inmates of the house.

4. It shall be lawful for the Chairman and the medical officer, on the notice given by them in writing to the occupier of any infected house or place, to cause persons infected with cholera, smallpox, chickenpox, or other infectious or contagious disease in any house or place hereunder described to be removed to some public hospital or other place provided by Government.

- (a) In any house or place in which goods are exposed for sale.
- (b) In any house or place of public resort.
- (c) In any building in which there are no means of isolating the patients from the other inmates, or in any building when the retention of the patient is likely to prove a source of danger to others.

Provided that it shall be competent for any such authorised person as aforesaid, in case the removal of any person so infected in any house or place in which goods are exposed for sale is objected to, and the house or place is not otherwise open to objection, to allow the patient to be retained, on condition, however, that the sale of goods shall not be carried on in such house or place during such time as any person shall remain so infected in such house or place.

Provided further, that it shall be lawful for any such authorised person as aforesaid to allow any patient to be removed to any locality which such patient or his or her friends may choose, and to which the Medical authorities of the town or place, if any, do not object, instead of to the public hospital or place provided by Government.

5. All buildings appropriated as hospitals for smallpox or cholera shall be placed under quarantine whilst used for the above purposes; and no person other than the duly appointed attendants shall be allowed ingress or egress into or from such hospitals, for any purpose whatever, without the sanction of the medical officer in charge being first had or obtained; the burden of proof that such permission had been obtained being upon the person or persons charged with infraction of this rule.

The word "hospital" shall include all buildings containing an infected patient.

6. No patient shall be allowed to quit a hospital or temporary hospital until it be duly certified by the local medical officer that he is in a fit state to depart; and all clothing, mats, and utensils of all kinds used by and for him shall be either burnt or disinfected as the medical officer shall direct, and all temporary hospitals shall be burnt or disinfected as soon as their purpose has been served.

The proof that a medical certificate has been given shall lie on the patient.

No convalescent patient shall be allowed to bathe in any public place except those specially provided for such patients, until permitted so to do by the medical officer.

7. In the case of Anurádhapura or any village situated on or near a main road or minor road in charge of Public Works Department, the constable or local headman shall cause to be legibly affixed in conspicuous parts of the doors and walls of houses in which smallpox or cholera has appeared the words "smallpox" and "cholera" in Sinhalese and Tamil.

8. It shall be competent for any member of the Board or secretary thereof to order any house, or portion of a house, or articles therein, which by reason of the presence of a person affected with smallpox or cholera are likely to have retained infection, to be disinfected or cleansed, and the owner or occupant so ordered shall comply forthwith with the terms of the order.

9. The corpse of every person dying of smallpox or cholera shall be buried within six hours by the owners or other occupants of the premises on which the death occurred.

10. No corpse of a person dying from any cause whatever shall be buried at a depth of less than six feet.

11. No burials shall henceforth take place during the prevalence of any epidemic, endemic, or contagious disease except in grounds authorised by the local medical officer, or, if there be not such an officer, the local headman.

12. Any member of the Board or secretary, by order of the Board, may at any time issue directions to the owners or occupiers or persons having the care and ordering thereof.

(a) To cause all or any part of any house, dwelling, church, place of assembly or other building to be forthwith internally or externally limewashed or otherwise cleansed.

(b) To cause privies to be constructed where, by reason of overcrowding or absence of ventilation, it is desirable (if there be none) that they should exist.

(c) To cause cesspits or offensive drains to be filled up by the owners of the land on which they are found, and to cause others to be opened.

(d) To cause compounds to be cleansed and rubbish in them to be burnt.

(e) To cause compounds in populous localities to be fenced.

(f) To cause fences to be kept down to a maximum height of six feet, and all overhanging branches and foliage to be removed, and every person so ordered shall forthwith comply with such directions.

13. During prevalence of any epidemic, endemic, or contagious disease no person shall sell flesh, fish, or perishable food at Anurádhapura at any place other than the public markets, or a place approved by a member of the Board, or set apart by the Board for the sale of flesh or fish.

14. The owners of any animals which shall be found dead shall cause such animals to be immediately buried or cremated, and in cases where the owners are not known, the owners or occupier of any land on which such animals shall be found dead shall cause it to be immediately buried or cremated, and in default the constable or village headmen shall cause it to be done, the cost being in the latter case recoverable from the owners or occupiers.

15. No manures, bones, or other offensive matters shall be stored in the neighbourhood of private habitations.

16. The Board shall have the power of prohibiting the collection or assembling of people within five miles of any infected area.

17. It shall be competent for the Chairman, local medical officer, or secretary, in the event of the breach or neglect of compliance within reasonable time of any order issued in terms of the 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 13th sections of these by-laws, to cause all such requirements to be immediately performed by hired labour, and to recover the costs of their execution from the person by whose default resort to such course shall have become necessary as prescribed by clause 11 of Ordinance 15 of 1862.

18. All notices required to be served by breach of these rules shall be served in the manner provided for by the 10th clause of Ordinance 15 of 1862 in English and the local vernacular language, and signed by the Chairman or secretary.
