**THE CONSTITUTION OF THE DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA**

**Delegation of Powers by the National Police Commission in terms of Article 155J**

BY virtue of the powers vested in the National Police Commission in terms of Article 155J of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, the said National Police Commission does hereby -

1. Delegate to Inspector General of Police and other Police Officers in terms of Article 155J specified in Column III of the Schedule hereto, its power of appointment, promotion, transfer, disciplinary control and dismissal as are specified in Column II of the Schedule hereto, in respect of the categories of Police Officers as are specified in Column I of the Schedule hereto.

Provided that in the event of any question arising in respect of any delegation or as to the implementation of delegation made by the National Police Commission so made, the decision of the National Police Commission shall be final and conclusive.

Provided further that, if any of the Police Officer specified in Column III is the complainant or a witness or a potential witness at any disciplinary inquiry against a police officer specified in Column I, the National Police Commission shall notwithstanding any delegation which may have been made by it, continue to exercise its power of appointment, promotion, transfer, disciplinary control and dismissal as are specified in Column II of the Schedule hereto as if no delegation in respect thereof had been made.

2. Specify that in the exercise of the powers herein delegated, Inspector General of Police and the other police officers to whom such powers are delegated shall at all times comply with the Procedural Rules, in respect of appointment, promotion and transfer of police officers, made by the National Police Commission in terms of Article 155G of the Constitution and also with such conditions and any Rules, Regulations and other Procedures which the said Commission may from time to time determine :



Provided that till such time as the Commission promulgates any Rules, Regulations or Procedure in terms of Article 155G of the Constitution in respect of matters not provided in the said Procedural Rules, all other Rules, Regulations and Procedures relating to police service as were in force on the date of the coming into operation of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution, shall *mutatis mutandis* continue to be in force and apply to the Police Service as if they have been made or provided by the National Police Commission.

3. Exercise directly in respect of the police officers not specifically mentioned in the Schedule hereto, the powers vested in it in terms of Article 155G of the Constitution :

4. Specify that this delegation will take effect from 4th of November 2015.
