Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 1 of 1893.

An Ordinance to amend "The Petroleum Ordinance, 1887."

A. E. HAVELOCK.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ordinance No. 6 of 1887, intituled "The Petroleum Ordinance, 1887": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Petroleum Amendment Ordinance, 1893," and shall come into force on the Thirty-first day of December, 1893.

Date of operation.

Ordinance to be construed as one with Ordinance No. 6 of 1887.

2 "The Petroleum Ordinance, 1887," is hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance, and the principal Ordinance and this Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Petroleum Ordinances, 1887 and 1893," and this Ordinance shall be construed as one with the principal Ordinance; and the expression "this Ordinance" in the principal Ordinance, and any expression referring to the principal Ordinance which occurs in any Ordinance or other document, shall be construed to mean the principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.

Amendment of section 19 of Ordinance No. 6 of 1887 as to the quantity to be conveyed.

As to the conveyance in a closed vessel or cart.

3 (1) To sub-section (a) of section 19 of the principal Ordinance the following words shall be added, namely, "except when conveyed in a cart specially constructed for the purpose, which has been licensed by writing under the hand of the local authority for the conveyance of petroleum."

(2) In sub-section (b) of the same section after the word "vessel" and before the words "so constructed" the words "or cart" shall be inserted.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 2 of 1893.

An Ordinance relating to the sale by retail of Opium and Bhang within Municipalities and Local Board Towns.

A. E. HAVELOCK.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Opium and Bhang Ordinance, 1878," and to extend certain of the provisions of the Ordinance No. 9 of 1889, intituled "An Ordinance relating to the sale by retail of Opium and Bhang within the Colombo Municipality," to other Municipalities, and also to any town in which a Local Board has

been established : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

To be read as one with Ordinances Nos. 4 of 1878 and 9 of 1889.

Governor may bring any municipality or local board under the operation of this Ordinance.

Section 7 of the Ordinance No. 4 of 1878 shall not apply to any town brought under the operation of this Ordinance.

Number of licenses and conditions to be attached thereto to be annually published.

Sections 4, 5, 6, and 7 of the Ordinance No. 9 of 1889 extended to towns brought under the operation of this Ordinance.

Re-sale at risk of purchaser.

1 This Ordinance and the Ordinances No. 4 of 1878 and No. 9 of 1889 shall be taken and read as one Ordinance.

2 From and after the date at which this Ordinance shall come into operation it shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, by Proclamation to be for that purpose published in the *Government Gazette*, to bring any town in which a municipality or local board has been or may be established, other than Colombo, under the operation of this Ordinance, and such Proclamation to amend, alter, or revoke as and whenever the Governor shall, with the like advice, determine.

3 The provisions of section 7 of the Ordinance No. 4 of 1878, relating to the granting of licenses to sell by retail opium and bhang, and the fees to be paid for such licenses, shall not apply to any town brought under the operation of this Ordinance, and licenses to sell by retail opium and bhang within the limits of any such town shall be granted only as herein provided.

4 The chairman of the municipal council or of the local board shall, on or before the 30th day of November in each year, cause to be published twice at least in the *Government Gazette* and in one or more of the local newspapers a notice declaring the number of licenses for the sale by retail of opium and bhang within the limits of any such town which shall be granted for the year commencing the first day of January then next. The number of such licenses so to be granted shall be in the discretion of the said council or board, but shall in no case exceed five within the limits of any municipal council and three within the limits of any local board for any one year.

5 The provisions of sections 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Ordinance No. 9 of 1889 shall extend to any town brought under the operation of this Ordinance.

6 In the event of any such re-sale as by section 6 of the Ordinance No. 9 of 1889 mentioned realising a smaller amount than that at which the highest bidder at the previous sale had been declared the purchaser, such highest bidder shall be liable for the difference, which shall be recoverable by action, notwithstanding the amount may exceed the sum of one hundred rupees, in a court of requests having in other respects jurisdiction in that behalf.

An Ordinance for making final provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1892.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by an Ordinance No. 25 of 1892 it was enacted that a sum of Rs. 1,099,582·05 should be charged upon the revenue of this Island for the Supplementary Contingent Services of the year One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-two, in addition to the sum of Rs. 12,309,914 provided by the Ordinance No. 22 of 1891: And whereas an expenditure of Rs. 74,666·75 was incurred and brought to account for the Contingent Services of the year 1892, for which provision is not made by the aforesaid Ordinances: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Rs. 74,666·75 charged upon the revenue of this Island of the year 1892 for the final Supplementary Contingent Services of that year.

1 That a sum not exceeding Seventy-four thousand Six hundred and Sixty-six rupees and Seventy-five cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this Island of the said year 1892, for the services hereinafter mentioned; the said expenditure being in conformity with the Schedule hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract :—

An Ordinance to amend "The Village Communities Ordinance, 1889."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter and amend in certain particulars "The Village Communities Ordinance, 1889," hereinafter called the principal Ordinance: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Governor may exempt any division or part thereof from the operation of this Ordinance.

1 After section 4 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be added, and numbered 4 (a), namely:—

"It shall be lawful for the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, by Proclamation from time to time to be issued by him for that purpose, to exempt from the operation of this Ordinance any chief headman's division or part thereof which shall have been brought within the operation of this Ordinance under section 4. On such Proclamation being issued, the said division or part thereof shall cease to be liable to the provisions of this Ordinance."

To be read as one with Ordinance No. 24 of 1889.

2 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Village Communities Amendment Ordinance, 1893," and shall be read as one with the principal Ordinance.

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION OF THE PETROLEUM STORAGE COMPANY, LIMITED.

It is agreed that the regulations contained in the Table C in the schedule annexed to “The Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1861,” subject to the hereinafter-mentioned modifications, shall be deemed to be the regulations of the Company. The modifications are as follows :—

Transfer of Shares.—The Directors may decline to register the transfer of any share or shares held by a Shareholder which in the interest of the Company they deem it inexpedient to register.

Every instrument of transfer shall be left at the office of the Company for approval by the Directors, accompanied by such evidence as may be required by the Directors to prove the title of the transferor. If the transfer be approved, such approval shall be certified in writing under the hand of one of the Directors and the Secretaries endorsed on such instrument of transfer, and the Company shall thereupon register the transferee as a Shareholder. If the transfer be not approved, the proposed transfer shall be absolutely void, and notice of non-approval shall be sent to the Shareholder intending to transfer such share. If no notice of non-approval shall be sent to the Shareholder within thirty days, the transfer shall be deemed to have been approved.

Increase of Capital.—The capital may be increased or decreased with the sanction of the Shareholders given by a special resolution at an Extraordinary General Meeting of the Company held for the purpose, of which seven days' notice by registered letter shall have been previously given.

Quorum at General Meeting.—No business shall be transacted at any meeting except the declaration of a dividend, unless a quorum of Shareholders is present at the commencement of such business, and five Shareholders shall form a quorum.

Directors.—Until other or further provision is made at the first Ordinary General Meeting, the number of Directors shall be three, of whom two shall form a quorum, and the first Directors shall be Messrs. George Chapman Walker, William Henry Figg, and John Frederick Baker. The later will join the Board immediately after allotment. Every Director shall hold not less than ten shares in the Company.

As remuneration for their services, the Directors shall be entitled to appropriate the sum of thirty rupees a meeting for each Director present at such meeting, but the Company in General Meeting may at any time alter the amount of such remuneration for the future.

Powers of Directors.—Directors shall have the power to do the following things in the name and on behalf of the Company :—

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance for making provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1893.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 26 of 1892 it was enacted that a sum not exceeding Twelve million Five hundred and thirty-six thousand Eight hundred and seventeen rupees should be charged upon the revenue of this Island for the Contingent Service of the year One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-three, and it has become necessary to make further provision for the service of the said year: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Rs.1,040,572.44 to be charged upon the revenue of this Island for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1893.

1 That a sum not exceeding One million and Forty thousand Five hundred and seventy-two rupees and Forty-four cents shall be, and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this Island for the services hereinafter mentioned; and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the details of the estimates specified in the Schedule A hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract :—

3 The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be therein mentioned; and he shall and may receive credit for the same accordingly.

ABSTRACT OF SEASON REPORTS FOR OCTOBER, 1893.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy.—The yala crop has been reaped and gathered. For maha, the sowing has been completed everywhere except in Siyané Kóralé East, where it has been delayed by want of rain, which has injuriously affected the growth of the plants in other parts of the district. The recent rains will, it is hoped, remedy this. In the Héwágam kóralé preparations are being made for the intermediate cultivation known locally as "muttes."

NEGOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Maha prospects in both kóralés middling. The rains, which were late, were much wanted. A fair yala harvest has been reaped and threshed.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Preparations are now being made for the maha cultivation. Weather favourable. The usual extent is being prepared.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Udunuwara : maha paddy being transplanted. Yatinuwara : yala paddy harvest good maha prospects poor for want of rain ; yala kurakkan good crop. Tumpane : maha paddy being transplanted ; yala harvest fair. Harispattu : yala paddy harvest fair ; maha being transplanted, fair prospects ; yala kurakkan harvest good. Pata Dumbara : maha paddy being transplanted ; drought interfered with cultivation. Pata Héwáheta : paddy fields being sown, and chenas also. Udapalata : maha paddy being weeded ; rain much wanted.

MÁTALÉ DISTRICT.

The rainfall, though late, is fair ; and the maha cultivation has begun in Matale South with bala-wi ; chenas are being sown ; Coast rice very dear ; tanks not yet full.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Kotmalé : paddy plants weeded and transplanted ; kurakkan reaped, crop somewhat damaged. Uda Héwáheta : paddy in ear ; chenas sown with kurakkan. Walapané : young paddy plants damaged in some villages owing to insufficiency of rain water ; chenas were burnt and cleared for kurakkan.

NORTHERN PROVINCE.

JAFFNA DISTRICT.

Rainfall.—With the exception of some very partial showers from 7th to the 11th and 19th to 31st, no rain during month.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Sowing of paddy almost completed, but for want of rain seeds did not germinate in some divisions, and in others the plants that came up withered ; unsettled weather during month ; rain much wanted, otherwise total failure of paddy crop apprehended. Dry grains : varaku, kurakkan, and chamy are suffering for want of rain.

MANNAR DISTRICT.

[Report not received.]

MULLAITTIVU DISTRICT.

Some heavy rain during month. Sowing general, and paddy is sprouting.

VAVUNIYA DISTRICT.

Enough water for sowing collected in some tanks of Kilakkumulai; chenas being sown with kurakkan in Kilakkumulai and Cheddikulam; kurakkan in Panankamam coming up well, and paddy thriving; in five tank beds good; rain in first part of month; relief works being closed.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

GALLE DISTRICT.

Paddy.—Cultivation for maha is over except in Hinidum pattu, where it has not been completed for want of rain; generally the condition of the paddy plants is good.

MATARA DISTRICT.

Paddy and fine grain good all throughout the district.

HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Young crops throughout district; too early to express opinion as to prospects.

EASTERN PROVINCE.

BATTICALOA DISTRICT.

[Report not received.]

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT.

No rain yet; munmari cultivation is suspended; paddy crops on lands where irrigation is not available are withering; a good return from munmari crops cannot be anticipated if no rain within next fortnight.

NORTH-WESTERN PROVINCE.

KURUNĒGALA DISTRICT.

Rainfall.—In all divisions rain disappointedly light and unequally distributed; particularly partial beyond the Deduru-oya.

Paddy and Chena Cultivation.—The early maha sowing is believed to be now safe; chenas and late maha fields were being sown wherever rain had fallen.

Cattle Disease.—Cattle were free from disease; pasturage improved.

Public Health was good.

Relief Works in distressed korales of Wannī drew increasing numbers until rain fell.

CHILAW DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Northern division: fields sown for maha; chenas cleared and partly sown; rain not sufficient. Central division: no paddy sown during the month; fields sown in August thriving well, except about 200 bushels' extent damaged by drought; chenas being sown with kurakkan; those sown in time are in good condition. Southern division: paddy cultivation for maha over, and last yala crop gathered; weather favourable for fine grain cultivation; tobacco being cut and cured.

PUTTALAM DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Paddy and fine grain sown in some villages of Puttalam pattu; reports from headmen of the other pattus not received as yet.

NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

North-east monsoon set in, but rain slight and very local; tanks here and there have risen, but the majority are still dry; paddy cultivation therefore generally delayed; chena cultivation going on; prices of grain rising daily; scarcity of food reported from Nuwaragam and Hurulu palatas.

PROVINCE OF UVA.

No standing crop; threshing of yala crop; yield generally below average; preparation for next cultivation going on; sowing of chenas delayed for want of rain; chena clearings finished.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Cultivation of fields for maha throughout the district progresses in favourable weather; young plants on some fields; yala crops successfully gathered, except in Nawadun koralé, where fields are ready for sowing; plants on chenas cultivated with el-vi looks well; kurakkan chenas sown in Atakalan korale, and are ready for sowing in Kolonnā and Meda koralés; in Kukulu koralé amu crop hindered by rain.

KĒGALLA DISTRICT.

Paddy and Dry Grain.—Paddy sown for maha being transplanted, prospects generally good; late yala fields, which were recently reaped, are being prepared for maha cultivation; weather favourable; late yala fields being harvested in Galboda and Kinigoda koralés, yield middling; harvest over in Beligal koralé, Paranakuru koralé, Three Koralés, and Lower Bulatgama, fair in Galboda and Kinigoda koralés; chenas are being weeded; iringu prospects good in Beligal koralé, fair in Galboda and Kinigoda koralés; kurakkan being sown throughout the district under favourable conditions; amu prospects good in Beligal koralé and Three Koralés and Lower Bulatgama, fair in Paranakuru koralé and Galboda and Kinigoda koralés; mun and meneri sown in Beligal koralé thriving well.

Cattle Disease.—The district is free from cattle disease.

General outlook satisfactory; the health of the district is now good.
