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### DRAFT ORDINANCES.

#### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance relating to the Short Titles of Ordinances.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is desirable to facilitate the citation of Ordinances by reference to the number as well as the subject of the Ordinances: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Short Titles (Numeration) Ordinance, No. of 1912."

Power of Clerk to insert number of Ordinance in short title.

2 It shall be lawful for the Clerk to the Legislative Council to insert in the short title to any Ordinance, at the time of the presentation of the Ordinance for the approval of the Governor, or in the case of Ordinances reserved for the Royal consideration, upon the notification of His Majesty's pleasure, the serial number assigned to the Ordinance.

Power of Clerk in certain cases to correct year and short title.

3 In the event of an Ordinance reserved for the Royal consideration being passed in one year and approved by His Majesty in the next or any succeeding year, it shall be lawful for the Clerk to the Legislative Council, in addition to inserting

the number of the Ordinance, to make any such modification of the date cited in the short title as may be necessary to adapt the short title to the circumstances of the case.

Short title so dealt with to be deemed to have been passed.

4. A short title supplemented or modified by the Clerk of the Legislative Council under this Ordinance shall be deemed to have been passed by the Legislative Council in the form so supplemented or modified.

Retrospective effect of Ordinance.

5. This Ordinance shall be deemed to take effect as from the commencement of the present Session.

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

THE object of this Ordinance is to give formal legislative sanction to the practice adopted during the present Session, by virtue of which the number of each Ordinance has been included in its "short title," being inserted by the Clerk before presentation to the Governor's signature.

2. The reason for the adoption of the practice in question is that, inasmuch as the Legislative Enactments of Ceylon are not published in separately indexed annual parts, but are published with continuous paging, the absence of the serial number of the Ordinance from the short title makes it more difficult to find the Ordinance cited by its short title than if it is cited simply by reference to its number and year, while if it is cited in the latter manner such a citation gives no conception of the nature of the Ordinance. If the short title contains both the subject and the serial number, the person reading the citation knows at once the nature of the Ordinance, and where it is to be found.

3. As in certain cases an Ordinance may, if reserved for the Royal Consideration, be approved in a year subsequent to that in which it was passed, it is desirable that the Clerk should be empowered to make the necessary correction in the date mentioned in the short title. At present it is declared by the Governor's Instructions that when an Ordinance so reserved receives the Royal Assent in a year subsequent to that in which it is passed, it must be numbered as of the year in which it received the Royal Assent. There is, however, no power to alter the short title as passed so as to harmonize it with this Instruction. This anomaly the present Ordinance will incidentally rectify.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Ceylon Post Office Ordinance, 1908" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Ceylon Post Office (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1912," and shall be read as one with the principal Ordinance.

Addition of a section.

2. The following section shall be added to the principal Ordinance immediately after section 58 and numbered 58 A:

Exemption from stamp duty.

58 A. No power, warrant, or letter of attorney given by any depositor in the Post Office Savings Bank to any other person authorizing him to make any deposit of any sum of money in the said bank on behalf of the said depositor, or to sign any document or instrument required by any rule made under this Ordinance to be signed on making such deposit, or to receive back any sum of money deposited in the said bank, or the dividends or interest arising therefrom, nor any receipt nor any entry in any book of receipts for money deposited in the said bank, nor for any money received by any depositor, his executors or administrators, assigns, attorneys, or agents, from the funds thereof, nor any draft

or order, nor any appointment of any agent, nor any certificate or other instrument for the revocation of such appointment, nor any bond or other instrument or document whatsoever required or authorized to be given, issued, signed, made, or produced in pursuance of this Ordinance, or of the rules made thereunder, shall be subject to or be charged with any stamp duty or duties whatsoever.

3 This section shall be deemed to have been in force as from the commencement of "The Stamp Ordinance, 1909."

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

It has always been the settled policy in regard to the Post Office Savings Bank to exempt all documents filed by depositors or in connection with the accounts of depositors from stamp duty. It has recently been discovered, however, that by the effect of one of the changes introduced in the law by "The Stamp Ordinance, No. 22 of 1909," all "declarations" made by depositors are liable to stamp duty under item 3 of Part I. of Schedule B.

2. As this was clearly not the intention of the Legislature, it is proposed to enact (with some modifications) a clause taken from section 30 of Ordinance No. 12 of 1859, which exempted the transactions of the Ceylon Savings Bank from all stamp duties to which they would otherwise have been liable.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 393 of the Criminal Procedure Code that the Solicitor-General may, by the direction, either general or special, of the Attorney-General, exercise all or any of the powers, except the powers of entering *nolle prosequi* and of pardoning an accomplice, conferred, and perform all or any of the duties imposed, upon the Attorney-General by the said Code:

It is hereby directed that, subject to the exceptions contained in the said section, the Solicitor-General shall exercise all the powers conferred, and perform all the duties imposed, upon the Attorney-General by the said Code.
