KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the yala crop is being reaped.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: (a) the supply of vegetables has been rather poor, but there was a fair supply of cassava and yams. Dessert fruits are out of season. (b) The flowering of coconuts was good. (c) The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated at 3,593,000 nuts.

Price of staple products: rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 6 a bushel; coconuts, Rs. 50 to Rs. 80 per thousand nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: generally speaking, the crops have been above the average. Some insect pest has done damage near Agalawatta, and in the case of very deep fields, the floods ruined the young plants.

Rainfall at Kalutara: total, 2.69 in.; mean, .09 in.

Health of people: generally good.
