#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha: the fields are now being sown. Yala: the plants are now reaped.

Dry grain: nil.

Other products: oranges, pineapples, breadfruits, and jak are scarce. Vegetables can be had at a moderate price. Coconuts are sold from Rs. 55 to 65 per thousand.

Price of staple products: imported rice is sold from Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel according to quality.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally: a good harvest is expected.

Rainfall: there have been no showers of rain during the month.

Health of the inhabitants: generally good.

Health of cattle: there have been several cases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth diseases in the korales, especially in Alutkuru Korale South.

### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

## KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha: ploughing and sowing in progress; yala: reaping in progress.
