# NOTIFICATIONS UNDER "THE PATENTS ORDINANCE, 1906."

THE following Specifications have been accepted: -- .

No. 1,288 of September 10, 1912.

William Jackson.—"Improvements in the feeding means of machines for drying tea-leaf, or other produce."

Abstract.—This invention relates to means for feeding drying machines which tea leaf or other produce to be dried. The drying machine is of the type in which heated air is forced or drawn into a chamber through which the tea leaf or other produce is conveyed on endless perforated or reticulated webs formed of tilting trays, so that the material is presented in even layers to the action of the heated air. The object of the invention is to provide a simple, efficient, and readily accessible device by which the tea leaf is fed into the machine in even layers from or near the floor or ground level, so as

to protect the operator as far as possible from the heat arising from the machine.

The uppermost endless belt of tilting trays used hitherto, in the type of drying machine referred to, is lengthened and extended through the front wall of the machine into a special projecting feeding chamber—chamber and belt inclining downwards at an angle of about 30° with the floor line. At the end of that projecting inclined chamber the tea leaf or other produce to be dried is fed, by an operator standing at or about floor level, on to that endless inclined belt whose upper run is travelling towards the drying chamber. The tea leaf is spread evenly over that upper run of the travelling belt by means of a rotary wiper preferably placed about midway of that inclined belt. The bottom run of that belt is caused to run over guides or rails, after it emerges from the drying chamber and enters the projecting feeding chamber, so as to keep the tilting trays flat for that part of the run, and so act as a conveyor for spilt leaf to convey it to the feeding end of that chamber. The bottom of the projecting feeding chamber is formed of sheet plate on which will be collected spilt leaf not otherwise intercepted. Apertures in the sides of the projecting feeding chamber are provided to allow such spilt leaf to be swept by hand down that inclined bottom surface towards the feeding end.

William Jackson.—" Improvements in the discharge means of machines for drying tea-leaf, or other produce." Abstract.—The object of this invention is to provide simple and efficient means for discharging dried tea leaf or other produce from drying chambers of the type where the tea leaf or other produce (for brevity referred to hereafter as tea leaf)

is carried upon an endless travelling web or webs which are reticulated and into which chamber hot air is forced.

According to this invention the chamber at the place of discharge of dried tea leaf is prolonged or extended so as to allow the lower edge of the guiding shoot at the charging part of the run of the endless web to be situated above a suspended and yieldable baffie near the discharging part of the run of the endless web, the arrangement being such as to prevent the heated air from finding too ready an escape at the discharge opening. The discharge door is arranged preferably horizontally, and to open outwards and downwards; and is hinged at one edge so that it can be opened at intervals by a lever secured to the hinged edge and acted upon at the requisite times by a lever operated directly or by gear from the axis of the pulley over which the web passes. The door is closed by a counter-balance weight or weights after it has been opened as described. There is no receiving discharge wheel or other obstruction in the space between the place where the tea leaf falls from the travelling web and the discharge door; and this space may be made of any required area to receive any required quantity of dried tea leaf before the discharge door is opened.

William Gough Firman.—" Improvements in and relating to tea-drying and like apparatus."

Abstract.—This invention relates to tea-drying and like arrangements in which the material to be dried or cured is

treated with heated air or carbolic acid or a mixture of the same.

The apparatus consists of a drying chamber having double walls at the sides; having a bottom formed mostly of tubes in connection with the hollow walls, but provided with hinged discharging doors; and of a top in which are hinged charging doors. Heated gas or air is led to the bottom of the chamber by a trunk. Stretching across the chamber are numerous perforated tubes capable of conveying hot gas or air from the hollow walls through the perforations into the interior of the chamber; and capable of being disconnected from the hollow walls and of conveying then hot gas or vapour through the perforations to the outside of the chamber.

The claims are :-

(1) Tea-drying and like apparatus comprising a chamber for containing the material to be dried and provided with a number of perforated tubes, pipes or the like adapted to be alternatively employed for permitting the ingress of heated gas to the material and egress of vapour from the chamber, substantially as described.

(2) In tea-drying apparatus as claimed in claim 1 providing double walls to the chamber for the purpose of producing gas passages and adapting the tubes to establish communication with such gas chambers when required, substantially as

described.

(3) In tea-drying or like apparatus as claimed in claim 2, rotatably mounting the tubes in the walls of the drying chamber and providing each tube with a port or ports adapted to open or close communication between the interior of the tube and the gas chamber, substantially as described.

(4) In tea-drying or like apparatus as claimed in the preceding claims, the provision of plugs or other closing means for closing the ends of the hollow perforated tubes when required.

(5) In tea-drying apparatus as claimed in the preceding claims the provision of discharging doors therein adapted also to act as heat radiators, substantially as described.

(6) Improved tea-drying or like apparatus substantially as hereinbefore described and as illustrated by the accompanying drawings.
