MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Rubber Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 1908."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Rubber Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 1908": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Rubber Thefts Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 191," and shall be read as one with "The Rubber Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 1908."

Addition of a new section.

2 After section 18 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be added:

18A. Every offence under this Ordinance shall be triable by a Police Court, and such court shall have power to inflict the full penalty prescribed for such offence by the said Ordinance, any provision of "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898," or of any other enactment to the contrary notwithstanding.

THE object of this Ordinance is to give Police Magistrates jurisdiction to try all offences under "The Rubber Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 1908," some of which at present are not triable by a Police Court.
