MUNICIPALITY OF GALLE.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Galle held in the Municipal Office on Saturday, August 10, 1912.

The Council met this day at 2 P.M., pursuant to notice dated August 5, 1912.

Present :—The Hon. Mr. R. B. Hellings, Chairman; Mr. D. G. Goonawardena; Mr. D. W. Subasingha; Dr. C. B. Lourensz; Mr. C. E. de Vos; Mr. G. E. Abeywardena; Mr. E. H. Vanderstraaten; and Mr. A. C. Hayley.

The Minutes of the General Meeting of Council held on July 13, 1912, copies of which were sent to each Member, were taken as read.

Resolved—That the Minutes of the General Meeting of Council held on July 13, 1912, be confirmed.

1. The Chairman having intimated that he had already called upon the Superintendent of Works to keep a diary, Mr. A. C. Hayley, with the permission of Council, withdrew the first motion standing in his name on the agenda.

2. Pursuant to notice Mr. A. C. Hayley moved—That the Superintendent of Works be informed that unless some improvement is noticeable in the state of the roads before the end of the current year, that he will be relieved of his duties in connection with the waterworks from January 1, 1913.

Mr. E. H. Vanderstraaten seconded. The motion, on being put to the Council was lost, two voting for and five against.

3. Pursuant to notice Mr. A. C. Hayley moved—That the Chairman be added to the following Special Committees, viz. :—

(1) To consider and report on an improved system of lighting the town.

(2) To inquire into and report as to what steps should be taken to improve the drainage of the town.

(3) To consider and report *re* the establishment of a home for consumptives and a dispensary for the treatment of cases of tuberculous diseases in Galle.

Mr. D. G. Goonawardena seconded.—Carried unanimously.

4. Pursuant to notice Mr. D. W. Subasingha moved—That in view of the great inconvenience and annoyance caused to the public by the extremely dusty condition of the Galle-Matara road, the Public Works Department be requested to take steps to abate or minimize the nuisance.

Mr. G. E. Abeywardena seconded. The motion on being put to the Council was lost, three voting for and five against.

5. Pursuant to notice Mr. D. W. Subasingha presented a petition from Maliduwa Seelaratana Terunnanse of Sumanarama temple in Kumbalwella, and moved—That the said temple, the lands belonging to it, and the residence of the priests be exempted from the payment of the assessment tax.

There being no seconder the motion fell to the ground.

6. Pursuant to notice the Chairman moved—That the posts of the two overseers of the Health Department, who draw salaries of Rs. 250 per annum each, be made pensionable under rule 2 of the Council's Pension Minute dated January 4, 1911.

Dr. C. B. Lourensz seconded.—Carried unanimously.

7. Pursuant to notice Mr. G. E. Abeywardena moved—That steps be taken by the Council to suppress the houses of ill-fame in Talbot town.

Mr. D. W. Subasingha seconded.—After some discussion the mover, with the permission of the Council and the consent of the seconder, amended his motion as follows, viz. :—That the Superintendent of Police be requested to take action to suppress the houses of ill-fame in Talbot town.

The motion as amended on being put to the Council was lost, three voting for and four against.

8. Letter No. 1,024 dated July 18, 1912, from the Chairman, Municipal Council, Colombo, stating that the Superintendent of the Fire Brigade is ill in hospital and that he will be instructed to proceed to Galle as soon as he recovers.—Read.

9. Chairman's Administration Report for 1911.—Deferred for next meeting in order that the report may be first circulated among the Members.

10. Letter No. 2,419 dated August 2, 1912, from the General Manager, Ceylon Government Railway, re extension of the roofing of the Galle Railway station to cover the recently extended portion of the platform.—Read.

11. Papers re pension of Inspector G. C. de Silva.

Resolved—That in view of the inability of the Chairman to give an unqualified certificate in respect to this officer's services, the Council approves of a deduction being made as provided for in rule 10 of the Council's Pension Minute of January 4, 1911, of Rs. 48 per annum from the sum of Rs. 288 to which this officer would be entitled to as pension.

12. Papers re pension of Overseer, Health Department, L. H. D. Abraham.

Resolved that a pension of Rs. 88 per annum be granted to L. H. D. Abraham, Overseer, Health Department.

NOTIFICATIONS UNDER "THE PATENTS ORDINANCE, 1906."

THE following Specifications have been accepted:—

No. 1,217 of October 24, 1911. (Date applied for under section 50 of the Ordinance, December 3, 1910.)

Alfred Parry.—"Improvements in or connected with Rolling Machines for tea and the like."

Abstract.—This invention has reference to machinery for rolling tea leaves and the like; more particularly to that type of machinery wherein the leaf is operated upon a surface between which and the leaf container there is a relative reciprocating sliding or vibratory movement and upon which surface the leaves are pressed, the pressure being generally exerted from above the rolling surface.

The chief object of the present invention is to provide machinery of the kind described which shall be more efficient than similar machinery hitherto employed.

The vessel or box in which the leaf to be rolled is contained describes in its motion an arc of a circle it being adapted to vibrate about an axis, preferably above it, from which it is suspended by rods and is caused to swing or vibrate about that axis of suspension by connecting rods driven from a crank shaft arranged at one end of the machine. The lower surface or table upon which the leaf is rolled has a surface made concave upwards; being made with a cylindrical surface of the same radius as the bottom of the container vibrating above it. This table is made to move with a reciprocating rectilinear motion transversely to the swinging motion of the container. That motion is imparted by connecting rods driven from a crank shaft arranged at one side of the machine and the table is constrained to move in one plane by suitable guides: A presser plate to press the tea leaf down in the container is operated through bevel gear and a screw from the front of the machine.

The claims are as follows:—

1. A leaf rolling machine of the kind herein referred to, wherein the leaf container has a vibratory movement in a curved path about its point of suspension over a concave leaf rolling table; substantially as described.
2. A leaf rolling machine of the kind herein referred to, where the leaf container is suspended and vibrated about its point of suspension in a curved path and a transversely reciprocated leaf rolling table is curved corresponding to the curved path, substantially as set forth.
3. A leaf rolling machine of the kind specified in Claim 2 wherein the motions are so proportioned that the coincidence of any two points, one of the container, and one of the table, only takes place in a relatively large number of vibrations or reciprocations of the container and the table; substantially as described.
4. A leaf rolling machine of the kind herein referred to, wherein the leaf container has a vibratory movement in a curved path about its point of suspension over a concave leaf rolling table, and a presser plate over the upper end of the container adapted to have movement in relation to the horizontal plane; substantially as set forth.
5. In a leaf rolling machine of the kind specified in Claim 4, a presser plate having on its under side a projecting rod or equivalent device for the prevention of balling of the leaf; substantially as and for the purposes set forth.
6. A leaf rolling machine having parts arranged and adapted to operate, substantially as set forth with reference to the drawings.

Jacob da Costa Gadelha.—"Implement for tapping trees."

Abstract.—This invention purports to be an improvement on the implement for tapping trees described in the Specification No. 1,271 by the same inventor. The implement is of the type in which incisions in the tree to be tapped are made by striking the implement against the tree after the manner of an axe or hatchet having double blades. In the present invention the double blades are made with the side edges returned so that a wedge of bark is cut, not only on two sides, as was done by the implement described in Specification No. 1,271, but at the ends as well; so that the wedge of bark is cut on all its sides and can be removed without tearing it away.

The claims are:—

1. An implement for tapping trees having two pivoted blades adapted to approach one another, when driven into the bark of a tree, characterized therein that the two blades are each provided with lateral cutting flanges which cut off the piece of bark to be severed from the tree at its ends.

2. An implement for tapping trees such as described and illustrated in the accompanying drawing.

Daniel Michel Weigel.—"A process for coagulating and defecating Caoutchouc from the natural juices, commonly called latex."

Abstract.—The method generally adopted by planters to recover Caoutchouc from latex is, it is stated, to add an acid. The resulting action is in reality, it is stated, a coagulation of the albumin in which the suspended particles of Caoutchouc are embedded together with fats and resins and other impurities. When precautions are not taken, that method of treating latex results in fermentation; and putrefaction and decomposition throughout the mass of coagulated albumin accompanies the fermentation.

The inventor states that fresh latex is slightly alkaline, and that while it remains alkaline no fermentation, putrefaction, or decomposition can develop. He accordingly adds an excess of alkali to the latex (preferably milk of lime) and so prevents acidity developing. But the addition of lime does not coagulate the Caoutchouc, it is stated. To promote coagulation the inventor adds carbonic acid gas—preferably the exhaust gases from an internal combustion engine. The coagulation takes place before the neutralization of the lime. The Caoutchouc rises, it is stated, in a flocculent non-adhesive mass of small granulars to the surface, and the carbonic acid gas unites with the lime to form carbonate of lime, which becomes precipitated and carries with it a large quantity of organic matter. Care must be taken not to carry the carbonation so far as to neutralise the alkalinity of the latex. Litmus paper can be used as a test. It is stated that the resultant coagulated Caoutchouc remains alkaline and therefore not liable to fermentation, decomposition, or putrefaction. The Caoutchouc after being washed is left to dry, preferably without pressing or rolling.

The claims are :—

1. In the process described for coagulating and defecating Caoutchouc from latex the use of any alkali or calcarious earth (preferably lime) added to the latex in the manner substantially as described for the purposes of preventing putrefaction, fermentation, and decomposition of Caoutchouc, and to destroy and precipitate the albumin, fats, and resins.
2. In the process described for coagulating and defecating Caoutchouc from latex the use of any alkali or calcarious earth (preferably lime) in combination with carbonic acid gas for the purposes of coagulating Caoutchouc from latex and precipitating or destroying or rendering inactive organic matter, in the manner substantially as described.
3. The use of the exhaust gases of internal combustion engines in combination with a limed solution, for the purposes of defecating and coagulating Caoutchouc from latex, in the manner substantially as described.

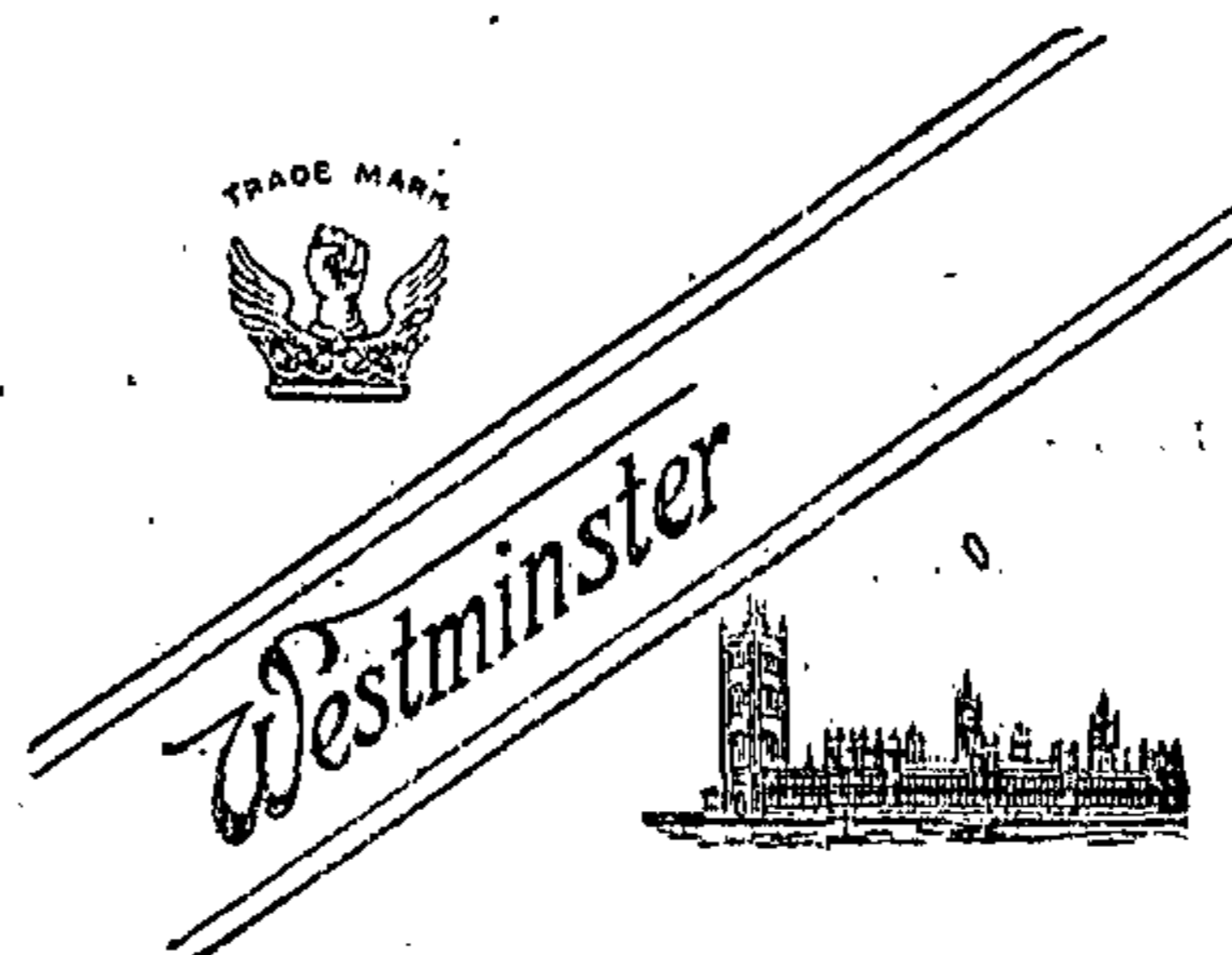
