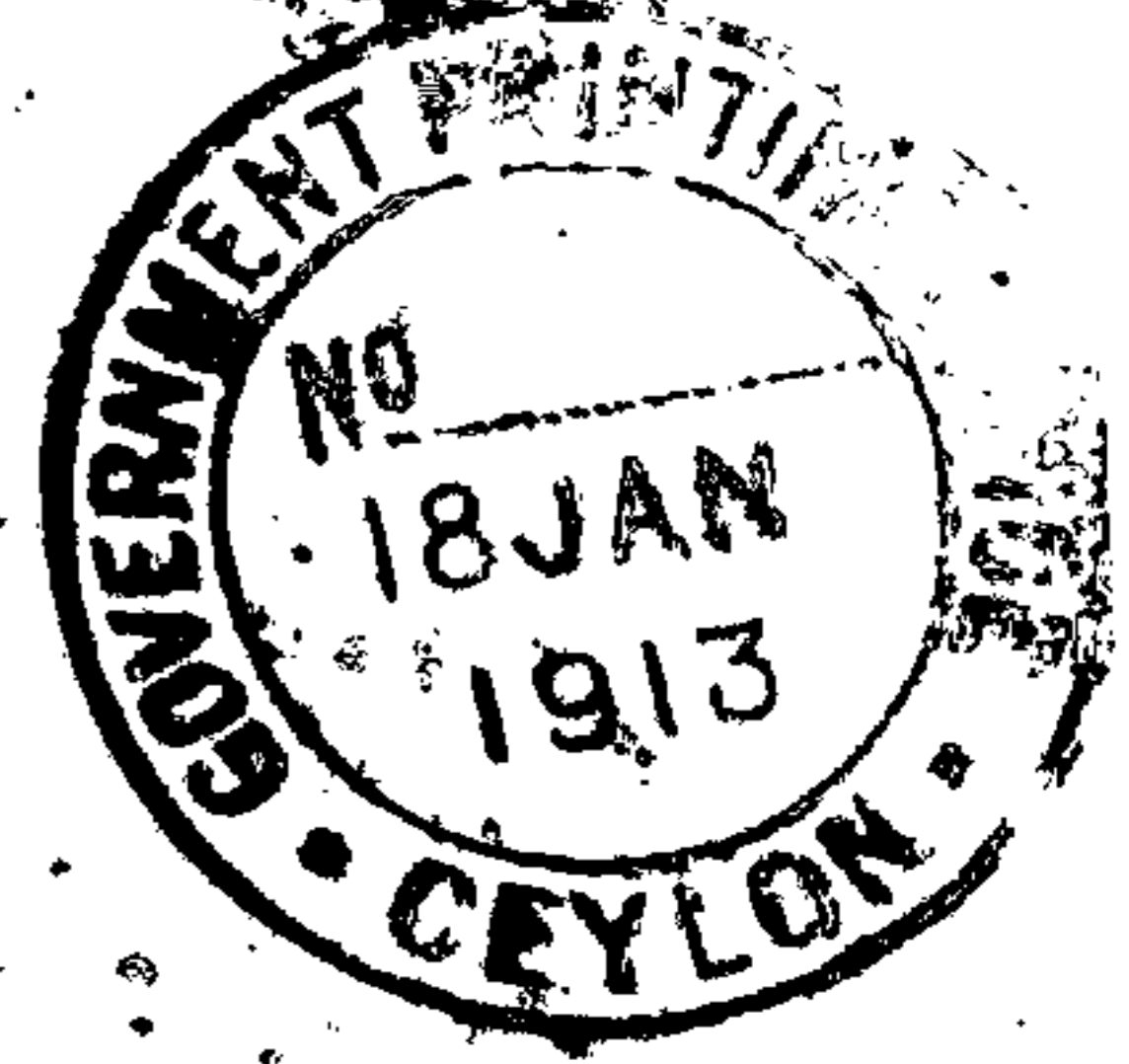
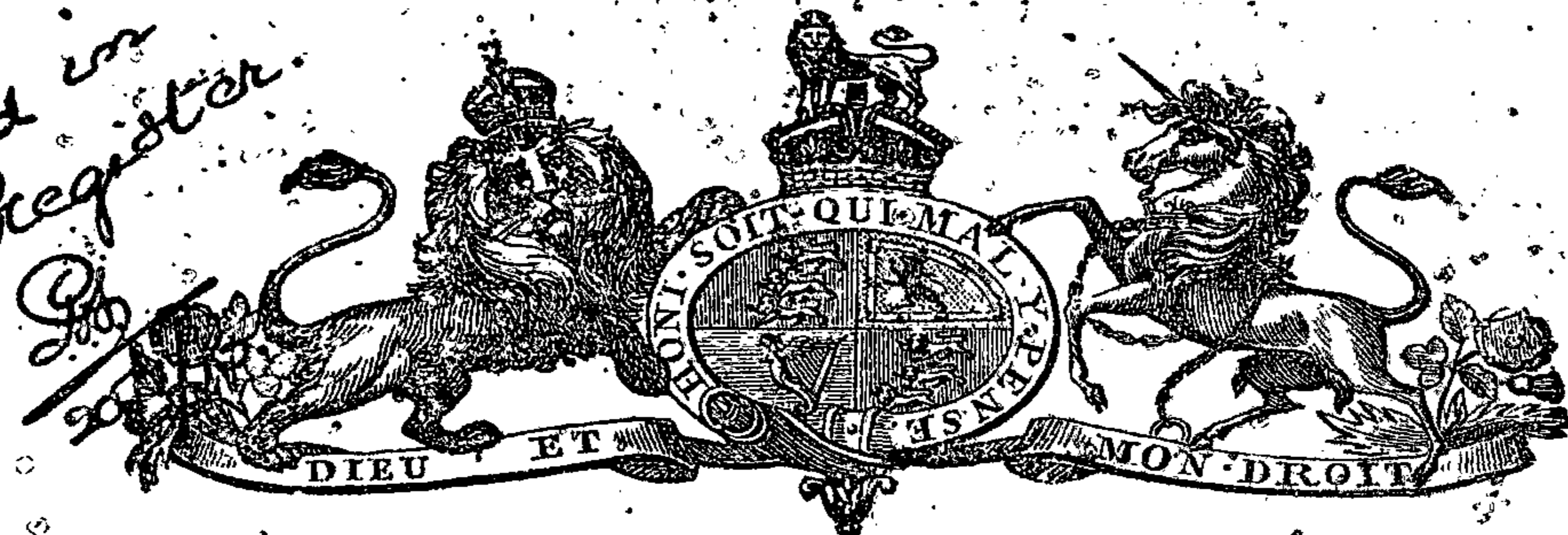

In the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir HENRY EDWARD McCALLUM, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS a road of one and a half mile in length, from Watagoda estate new factory to Kandnewera estate factory, in extension of the road of 5½ miles from railway bridge on Wariapola estate to Watagoda estate, in the Matale District of the Central Province, has been constructed by the proprietors of Kandnewera estate, in pursuance of section 38 of the Estate Roads Ordinance, No. 12 of 1902:

And whereas such proprietors have applied to the Governor that such first-mentioned road be treated as a road made under the said Ordinance, and it seems to Us expedient to declare that the said road shall be treated as a road made under the said Ordinance:

Now know Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, in exercise of the powers vested in Us by the said section of the said Ordinance, do hereby proclaim and declare that the said road of one and half mile in length, from Watagoda estate new factory to Kandnewera estate factory, in extension of the road of 5½ miles from railway bridge on Wariapola estate to Watagoda estate, in the Matale District of the Central Province, constructed by the proprietors of Kandnewera estate, shall, as from and after July 1, 1912, be treated as a road made under the said the Estate Roads Ordinance, No. 12 of 1902.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Tenth day of January, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Thirteen.

BY-LAWS REFERRED TO.

1 A. After any such public market has been established and opened, no person shall without a license granted by the Chairman of the Board publicly expose for sale any meat, poultry, fresh fish, fresh fruit, or vegetables in any place within the limits of the Board other than the public market.

1 B. All licenses referred to in the preceding by-laws shall be in the form annexed, and shall be in force for the period mentioned therein and no longer, which period shall not be more than twelve months or less than one month. Such licenses shall be issued free of payment. Provided that it shall be lawful for the Chairman of the Sanitary Board at any time to cancel any such license or licenses.

RULE 3.

As existing.

(i.) *Commissions.*—The Commanding Officer shall submit the names of trained Engineers, members of the Corps or otherwise, for the approval of His Excellency the Governor, for commissions, in accordance with the regulations in force for the time being.

As amended.

(i.) *Commissions.*—The Commanding Officers shall submit the names of members of the Corps or others for the approval of His Excellency the Governor for commissions, in accordance with the regulations in force for the time being.

RULE 8.

Agreement.—Every Officer on appointment and every Volunteer on enrolment shall, in addition to the oath of allegiance, sign the following:—

“I hereby agree to be bound by the Regimental Rules of the Corps, of which I have received a copy.”

Agreement.—Every Officer on appointment and every Volunteer on enrolment shall, in addition to the oath of allegiance, sign the following, viz.:—

“I hereby agree to be bound by the Regimental Rules of the Corps, of which I have received a copy, and further agree to make myself efficient for the three years following from the date of this agreement.”

RULE 18.

(ii.) *Non-Commissioned Officers and Men.* An enrolled Volunteer to whom uniform has been supplied at the expense of the Corps who fails to earn the capitation grant for the year in which he has been enrolled must pay to the Corps the cost of such uniform.

(ii.) *Non-Commissioned Officers and Men.* An enrolled Volunteer who fails to earn the capitation grant for the year in which he has been enrolled or any subsequent year of his period of agreement shall pay to the Corps the amount of such capitation grant or the cost of the uniform supplied to him at the expense of the Corps whichever is the greater.

RULE 33.

(i.) *Officers.*—(b) Mess dress: White jacket with rolled collar and stars; white overalls, scarlet cummerbund, patent leather parade boots. Field service cap, black peak and white cover, with badge.

(ii.) *Non-Commissioned Officers and Men.*—(f) Mess dress (optional): White drill shell jacket fastened by cord at collar.

Scarlet cummerbund.
Corps shoulder badges, &c.

(i.) *Officers.*—(b) Mess dress: White jacket rolled collar and shoulder straps with badges of rank, white overalls, scarlet cummerbund, patent leather boots. Field service cap with badge, black peak, white cover. (Optional for balls and dances only: blue overalls with red stripe 2 inches wide.)

(ii.) *Non-Commissioned Officers and Men.*—(f) Mess dress (optional): White drill shell jacket fastened by cord at collar.

Scarlet cummerbund.
Corps shoulder badges, &c.
For balls and dances only: blue overalls with red stripe 2 inches wide; pumps.

RULES REFERRED TO.

Prevention of Malaria.

1. It shall be the duty of every householder to keep his compound clear of all weeds and brushwood within 20 yards of his own or of his neighbours' houses, and to remove and burn all refuse, rubbish, tins, coconut shells, and other matter or receptacles which are likely to form breeding places for mosquitoes.

2. It shall also be the duty of every householder to fill in all hollows, holes, or other low places in his compound where water can collect and stagnate within 20 yards of his own or of his neighbours' houses on the receipt of a written notice from the Chairman of the Village Committee within fourteen days of the receipt of such notice. Provided that he shall have the right of appeal to the Government Agent against the order contained in such notice. In the event of any householder failing to comply with such notice or to lodge an appeal within the said fourteen days, it shall be lawful for the Chairman of the Village Committee to cause the work of filling to be done by labourers employed by the village headman, and to recover the cost of the work, together with reasonable cost of supervision, from such householder, in addition to such fine as may be lawfully imposed for the breach of this rule.

WITH reference to the Notification of June 6, 1912, appearing in the *Government Gazette* of June 14, 1912, the following amended scale of charges for paying patients in Government hospitals is published for information.

(2) The hospital charges for wives and children are to be the same as for the husband, father, mother, or guardian respectively.

(3) The Medical Superintendent or officer in charge shall insist on a written guarantee or a sufficient money deposit before admission is granted.

(4) No charges other than those stated above can be levied, except at the Baker's Ward, Nuwara Eliya, where the present Medical Officer is entitled to a charge of Rs. 5 per day as "medical fee."

(5) Admission can only be granted if accommodation is available at the rate to be charged.
