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MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Rural Schools Ordinance, 1907."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Rural Schools Ordinance, 1907": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Rural Schools (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1912."

Addition of new sections.

2 The following sections shall be added to the principal Ordinance:

42. In respect of each school division there shall be a separate fund; and the moneys placed at the disposal of the District School Committee under sections 17 and 24 in respect of each school division, together with the fines payable into the funds of each school division under section 37, shall be placed to the credit of the separate fund of such school division.

43. The District School Committee shall be entitled to take from the funds of any school division such sum or sums or a portion thereof as may be required to be applied in terms of this Ordinance in respect of any other school division. Provided, however, that the sum so taken shall be

repaid into the funds of the school division from which it was taken, as soon as in the opinion of the Chairman of the District School Committee the funds of the school division for the purposes of which the same was taken admit of such repayment in whole or in part.

Amendment of section 17.

3 In the first line of the proviso to section 17 of the principal Ordinance between the words " money and labour shall " and the words " be applied " there shall be inserted the words " subject to the provisions of section 43."

Amendment of section 24.

4 In the second line of the proviso to sub-section (3) of section 24 (2) of the principal Ordinance between the words " labour shall " and the words " be applied " there shall be inserted the words " subject to the provisions of section 43."

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE Ordinance No. 8 of 1907 provides that the money placed at the disposal of a District Committee under sections 17 and 24 by each school division shall be applied only for the purposes of that division. This provision has the effect of preventing even a temporary appropriation of such moneys to meet the pressing needs of another division.

The object of this Ordinance is to enable a District Committee to borrow from moneys lying to the credit of a school division and apply the same to meet the needs of another. It is specially provided that the money so borrowed shall be returned to the funds of the division from whose funds it was borrowed. The object aimed at by Ordinance No. 8 of 1907 is conserved, inasmuch as all the funds of a division will ultimately be spent on that division alone.
