DRAFT ORDINANCES.

M I N U T E.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to empower Police Magistrates to try certain Offences in a summary way.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make further provision empowering police magistrates to try in a summary way certain petty offences : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Power to try in a summary way.

1 Notwithstanding anything contained in "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1883," and "The Criminal Procedure Code Amendment Ordinance, 1890," any police magistrate specially empowered in this behalf in manner hereinafter provided may try in a summary way all or any of the following offences :—

- (a) Offences against the Ceylon Penal Code, sections 156, 257, 258, 259, 270, 271, 272, 278, 279, 282, 283, 285, 286, 287, 314, 325, 327, 332, 343, 409, 433, 434, 484, and 488.
- (b) Theft under sections 367, 369, and 370 of the same Code, where the value of the property stolen does not exceed fifty rupees.
- (c) Receiving or retaining stolen property under section 394 of the same Code, where the value of such property does not exceed fifty rupees.
- (d) Assisting in the concealment or disposal of stolen property under section 396 of the same Code, where the value does not exceed fifty rupees.
- (e) Offences against any other Ordinance and against the by-laws, rules, or regulations made under or in pursuance thereof punishable with a fine not exceeding Rs. 25, or with imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or with both.
- (f) Abetment of any of the foregoing offences.
- (g) An attempt to commit any of the foregoing offences when such attempt is an offence.

Procedure.

2 In trials under this Ordinance the procedure prescribed in "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1883," as amended by "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1890," for cases where a police court has power to try summarily, shall be followed, subject to the provisions hereinafter contained.

Limit of imprisonment.

No sentence of imprisonment exceeding one month, or fine exceeding twenty-five rupees, shall be passed in the case of any conviction under this Ordinance.

Need not record evidence.

3 In cases tried under this Ordinance, subject to the provisions hereinafter contained, the police magistrate need not record the evidence of the witnesses or frame a formal charge, but he shall enter in such form, as the Governor in Executive Council may direct, the following particulars —

- (a) the serial number ;
- (b) the date of the commission of the offence ;
- (c) the date of report or complaint ;
- (d) the name of the complainant (if any) ;
- (e) the name and residence of the accused ;
- (f) the names of the witnesses (if any) ;
- (g) the offence complained of, and the offence (if any) proved, and in cases coming under sub-section (b), sub-section (c), or sub-section (d) of section 1, the value of the property in respect of which the offence has been committed ;

- (h) the plea of the accused and his examination (if any);
 (i) the finding, and a brief statement of the reasons therefor;
 (j) the sentence or other final order; and
 (k) the date on which the proceedings terminated.

Record in case of acquittal.

4 In every case tried under this Ordinance in which an accused is acquitted, the police magistrate shall, before pronouncing a verdict, record a judgment embodying the substance of the evidence, and also the particulars mentioned in the preceding section. Such judgment shall be the only record in cases coming within this section.

Record after notice of appeal.

5 In every case tried under this Ordinance in which notice is given to the police magistrate within twenty-four hours after the passing of the sentence, that an appeal will be taken upon a matter of law, or in which the police magistrate grants leave to appeal, the police magistrate shall record a statement embodying the substance of the evidence. Such statement and the particulars mentioned in section 3 shall be the only record in cases coming within this section.

Governor may empower magistrates to act under this Ordinance.

6 The Governor in Executive Council, after consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court, may, by notification in the *Government Gazette*, confer on any police magistrate power to try in a summary way under the provisions of this Ordinance all or any of the offences mentioned in section 1.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General and Adjourned Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, December 18, 1891.

The Council met this day at 3 p.m., pursuant to notice dated December 12, 1891.

Present :—Mr. H. H. Cameron, Mayor and Chairman; Hon. J. J. Grinlinton; Dr. W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Mr. J. S. Drieberg; Captain F. Bayley; Mr. C. S. Hay; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Mr. H. van Cuylenberg; Mr. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. D. F. Browne; and Mr. R. H. Morgan.

1. Mr. Coomaraswamy moved "that this General Meeting do stand adjourned until the business appointed for the Adjourned Meeting fixed for this day—viz, the consideration of the Budget for 1892 and a Supplemental Budget No. 3—is concluded; and that the business for the Adjourned Meeting be now proceeded with.

The Chairman seconded.—Carried.

2. Resolved,—That the Council do go into Committee to resume consideration of the Budget for 1892.

3. Resolved,—That the sum of Rs. 6,000 for "Working of Dredger" be voted, and that a statement showing the results of the working of the dredger be submitted monthly.

4. Resolved,—That the vote of Rs. 3,546 proposed as "Cost of Collection" in the Assessment Account be omitted, and that an equal sum be reserved.

6. Resolved,—That the vote for "Lighting Public Streets" be increased to Rs. 68,124, and that, instead of the proposed vote of Rs. 8,408-50 for "Extension of Street Lighting," a sum of Rs. 5,000 be reserved for that purpose.

7. Resolved,—That the vote of Rs. 9,062-50 for "Salaries" in the Assessment Account be increased to Rs. 15,062-50 by the inclusion of half the salary of the Chairman.

The Minutes of November 13 and December 4 and 7, 1891, having been printed and a copy sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of November 13 and December 4 and 7, 1891, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice the Chairman moved "that this Council do offer to place at the disposal of Government a portion of the Floral Hall to be used as an Art Gallery and School of Art should the Government consent to carry into effect a proposal for the purchase of plaster casts from the antique made by Messrs. P. A. Templer and H. H. Cameron."

This motion was, by leave of Council, withdrawn.

2. Pursuant to notice, Captain Bayley moved "that the Superintendent of Works be requested to devise a scheme for the deepening, cleansing, and improvement of the lake, and that it be submitted to Council for its consideration."

This motion was, by leave of Council, amended by the addition of the words "at its next General Meeting."

The motion so amended was seconded by the Chairman and carried.

In this connection a letter dated December 3, 1891, from Hon. J. J. Grinlinton, submitting a statement of the work performed on the vote of Rs. 1,000, passed by the Council on October 9 last, for removing weeds, &c., from the lake, was read.

Grinlinton moved, with reference to the motion made by him and adopted by the Council on the 13th ultimo regarding the Galle Face esplanade, "that the request to hand over the esplanade to the Municipal Council be made to the Colonial Government instead of the Military authorities."

Captain Bayley seconded.—Carried.

6. The report of the Superintendent of Works received with letter No. 293 of November 13, 1891, and the report of the Consulting Engineer received with letter No. 67 of November 7, 1891, also the Sanitary Officer's report dated December 8, 1891, with reference to the lake, were laid on the table.

Resolved,—That the consideration of the above reports be deferred until the next Meeting.

7. The letter dated November 6, 1891, from Hon. L. B. Clarence, inviting attention to the condition of the lake, was submitted.

Resolved,—That the letter be printed and circulated and considered at the next Meeting.

8. The letter dated June 6, 1891, from Mr. Vincent Loos, with reference to the new road from the Maradana Junction, and connected papers, were submitted.

Resolved,—That the circulation of the papers be completed.
