Weather : the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura during the month under review was 3·20 in.  
 Cultivation, paddy : for lack of water in the tanks very little paddy cultivation has been done. Crops are about two months old. In a few villages fields are being ploughed. Kurakkan : crops are about two to three months old. Coconut flowering has been very poor. Crops gathered was approximately 4,000.  
 Health of people : fair.  
 Health of cattle : although rinderpest is abating, foot-and-mouth disease has broken out in several villages of Hurulu palata.  
 Tanks : with few exceptions there is little water in the tanks.

## BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather : generally wet.

Paddy : in some divisions yala crops are ripening, while in others fields are being ploughed.

Chenas : chena crops are thriving well.

Health of people : satisfactory, except for a few cases of fever, cold, and sore eyes.

Health of cattle : a few cases of rinderpest occurred at Buttala and Wellawaya. Hoof-and-mouth disease was prevalent in almost all the divisions.

Prices of staple products : rice, varies from Rs. 5.50 to Rs. 8; kurakkan, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2.25 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 10 to Rs. 16 per 100.

Rainfall : 14.94 in. as registered at the observatory.

## RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the crops on maha fields are blossoming, and in some parts the plants are young. In Atakalan korale the crops on maha fields are ripening. The weather is favourable.

Dry grain : the yala chenas in Kuruwiti, Nawadun, and Atakalan korales cultivated with el-paddy are blossoming and ripening. In Kukul korale the plants are young. The weather is favourable.

Other products—coconuts : crop satisfactory.

Health of people : satisfactory.
