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#### MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

#### MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, November 22, 1912.

THE Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated November 15, 1912.

Present:—Mr. C. R. Cumberland, Acting Chairman; Mr. C. P. Dias; the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G.; the Hon. Sir Allan Perry, Kt.; Major! A. W. de Wilton; Mr. N. H. M. Abdul Cader; Mr. Arthur Alvis; Mr. L. B. Fernando; Mr. E. G. Jayewardene; Dr. David Rockwood; Mr. A. J. Martin; Dr. D. P. Banajee; Dr. E. V. Ratnam; and Dr. W. P. Rodrigo.

1. The Minutes of General Meeting of October 25, 1912, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of Council, were taken as read.

Resolved that the Minutes of General Meeting of October 25, 1912, be confirmed.

With permission of Council item No. 9 in agenda was then taken up.

- 9. Pursuant to notice, the Chairman moved that this Council do decide that Mr. L. B. Fernando continue to be a Councillor, although he has failed to attend three consecutive General Meetings.

  Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.
- 2. Pursuant to notice, Mr. E. G. Jayewardene presented a petition from the residents of Maligawatta and moved that the same may be considered and that some measure of relief may be granted to the petitioners. Dr. W. P. Rodrigo seconded.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved as an amendment that the matter be referred to the Standing Committee on Finance and Works for report. The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G., seconded.

Whereupon Mr. E. G. Jayewardene withdrew his motion with leave of Council in favour of the amendment, which was carried.

2. (a) With permission of Council, Dr. E. V. Ratnam asked the Chairman with reference to the reply given by him on August 23 re house of detention for beggars what progress has been made so far.

The Chairman replied that the matter is in progress, and that he has submitted to Government suggestions for staff and an estimate of cost and is awaiting a reply.

3. With permission of Council Dr. W. P. Rodrigo withdrew the question standing in his name.

4. Pursuant to notice, Dr. W. P. Rodrigo asked the Chairman how many motor cars are owned by this Council and what their original cost has been, what they cost the Council now per annum for maintenance, &c., for whose use

they are provided and what other travelling allowances those officers are now drawing (the amount and nature.)

The Chairman replied that there are three cars, viz., the Chairman's car, the cost of which is Rs. 5,750, and the maintenance of it costing approximately Rs. 225 per mensem on the average, but only Rs. 145 for the last few months; the Waterworks Engineer's car, cost of which is Rs. 7,400, and maintenance Rs. 208 per mensem; and the Medical Officer of Health's car, costing Rs. 7,813.95 and maintenance of it amounting approximately to Rs. 203 per mensem. The Chairman said these cars are kept for the use of the Departments concerned, and the Chairman's car is occasionally used by Assistant Engineers, District Judges, and Council concerned in cases in which the Municipality is interested, &c.

As regards the travelling allowances the Chairman said they are as follows:—

Chairman, nil; Waterworks Engineer, Rs. 125 per month; Medical Officer of Health, Rs. 100 per month.

5. Pursuant to notice, Dr. W. P. Rodrigo asked the Chairman whether it has been brought to his notice that the Council's motor cars have been used by its officers for private purposes and whether such use is not in contravention of any rule or order passed by the Chairman or this Council.

The Chairman replied that one such case was brought to his notice and the officer concerned has been dealt with. Use of a car for private purposes is not contrary to any rule or order of the Council or Chairman, but is contrary to the

resolution of the Finance Committee.

6. Pursuant to notice, Dr. W. P. Rodrigo asked the Chairman whether he can say why the nomenclature of the nature of travelling allowances in the case of certain officers of this Council has been altered in the Budget of 1912–1913 from what it used to be in the previous Budget.

The Chairman replied that he understood that the designation of the travelling allowances had been altered in the present Budget to comply with a resolution of the Council of February 17, 1911, that the allowances should in all cases

be commuted, the officer making his own arrangement for his transport.

7. Pursuant to notice, Dr. W. P. Rodrigo asked the Chairman whether he is aware that certain officers who have been expected to keep two horses did not do so, and that the Auditor required a certificate upon honour that these horses were actually kept, and whether the nomenclature of the nature of travelling allowances was not altered after and as a consequence of such requests.

The Chairman replied that the only officers who were expected to keep two horses were the Chairman and the Municipal Engineer. Both did so until the use of a car was substituted for the Chairman's allowance and the allowance to the Municipal Engineer was commuted. He said he was unable to trace any question of the Colonial Auditor on the subject, and the designation of the allowances was altered in accordance with the resolution of Council as already stated.

8. Pursuant to notice, Dr. W. P. Rodrigo asked the Chairman whether he is aware of any officer who is now drawing Rs. 1,200 or 960 or 900 as travelling allowances per annum not keeping any other form of conveyance than one horse and one ricksha, and moved that sufficient steps be taken by the Chairman to prevent the misuse of the Council's cars and of the travelling allowances.

The Chairman replied to the first part of the question in the negative, and the other part was, by leave of Council,

withdrawn by Dr. Rodrigo.

- 10 and 11. Pursuant to notice, Mr. E. G. Jayewardene taking the two motions standing in his name together moved:—
  - (1) That no extension of any water main in the city be made without the sanction of the Works and Finance Committees of this Council being first obtained therefor, and without an estimate of work being submitted to and passed by the said Committees.

(2) That no application made for a private service of water by the owner or occupier of any house be refused without the previous sanction of this Council being obtained for such refusal. Dr. E. V. Ratnam

seconded.

The Chairman moved as an amendment that (1) and (2) be referred to the Finance and Works Committee as to what further restrictions, if any, should be placed on the action of the Waterworks Engineer in (a) expending money or minor extensions out of open votes; (b) in refusing to grant water service.

Mr. E. G. Jayewardene withdrew his motion in favour of the amendment, which was carried.

12, 13, and 14. The following extracts from Minutes of Standing Committees on Sanitation and Markets of November 13, 1912, on Finance of November 15, 1912, and on Municipal Works of November 15, 1912, were brought before Council, having been previously printed and circulated:—

(2) Passengers' latrine, Question of charging a fee: Letter from the City Sanitation Engineer, No. 235 of October 18, 1912.—Recommended that the charges be as follows:—Closets, 5 cents; basin (including towel), 5 cents; and that tenders be invited for the right to collect charges.

(3) Conversion of stall No. 3 of the Kollupitiya vegetable market into a beef stall at a rental of Rs. 15 per mensem. Recommended that an additional meat stall be allowed as proposed and that a trial be made of inviting

tenders for the meat stalls in this market.

(7) Lake dredger: Letter from the Works Engineer, No. 778 of November 8, 1912, suggesting the sale of the lake dredger to the Engineer, Lake Development Scheme.—Recommended.

(10) Supplemental vote of Rs. 3,970 · 50 to meet salary of Mr. J. H. Donkin, Mechanical Engineer.—Recommended. (11) Passengers' latrine, Question of charging a fee: Letter from the City Sanitation Engineer, No. 235 of October 18, 1912.—Recommended that the charges be as follows:—Closets, 5 cents; basin (including towel), 5 cents; and that tenders be invited for the right to collect charges.

(12) Supplemental vote of Rs. 3,000 to vote K 10/1 of 1911, "30-inch Main from Wellampitiya."—Recommended.

(13) Application from the Municipal Assessor for an Additional Assessing Inspector on Rs. 600 per annum and a

commuted allowance of Rs. 300 per annum.—Recommended as a temporary appointment.

(14) Transfer of Rs. 2,280 from vote No. 13,Upkeep of Latrines and Bathing Places, to vote I 36, Lighting of Munici-

(15) Tenders for the supply of ritis, firewood, boiled lime, yellow clay, unslacked lime, and white clay.—Recommended acceptance including Fernando's tender of 45 cents per bushel for lime.

- (16) To sanction increase of pay to the following members of the Drainage Works Staff from January 1, 1913:—
- (1) P. P. Perera from Rs. 85 to Rs. 90; (2) A. A. Jayasekera from Rs. 75 to Rs. 80; (3) V. E. Wijayasinghe from Rs. 55 to Rs. 60; (4) S. R. Fernando from Rs. 85 to Rs. 90; (5) R. H. P. Seneviratne from Rs. 50 to Rs. 55; (6) J. M. Valoopillai from Rs. 130 to Rs. 170 (no overtime to be allowed); (7) R. Lawton from Rs. 85 to Rs. 100 (no overtime to be allowed); (8) S. E. Ramalingam from Rs. 100 to Rs. 150 (no overtime to be allowed); and also the transfer of Mr. C. G. Pereira, Cost Clerk, from the daily-paid staff with an increase of pay from Rs. 2.50 per diem to Rs. 70 per mensem.—Recommended.

(17) Dr. W. P. Rodrigo's question re assessment rate.

Agreed that the reduction allowed by the Ordinance should be made.

13. With reference to item No. 7 of the Standing Committee on Finance of November 15, 1912, the Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper, C.M.G., moved that the words from "to" to "scheme" in the last line of the recommendation be deleted. The Chairman seconded.—Carried.

With reference to item No. 15 of the recommendations of the Standing Committee on Finance of November 15, 1912, it was resolved to omit the word "firewood."

Resolved that the remaining items of the recommendations of the Standing Committee on Finance of November 15, 1912, be adopted.

14. With reference to item No. 7 of the recommendations of the Standing Committee on Municipal Works of November 15, 1912, it was resolved to omit the words "to the Engineer, Lake Development Scheme."

Resolved that the recommendations of the Standing Committee on Municipal Works of November 15, 1912, be adopted as amended.

The Hon. Mr. F. A. Cooper moved that the Council do resume and that the recommendations as amended in Committee be adopted. Mr. Arthur Alvis seconded.—Carried.

15. Application from Mr. L. A. B. Peile, Superintendent of Fire Brigade, for 4 months' half-pay leave from November 7, 1912, to proceed to Europe.

The Chairman moved that Mr. Peile be granted 4 months' half-pay leave and that he do go before a Medical Board in England consisting of two Doctors to be nominated by the Crown Agents. Dr. David Rockwood seconded.—Carried.

  - 17. Report of the Medical Officer of Health for 3rd quarter, 1912, was laid on the table.
- 18. To sanction excess leave of 16 days over 30 days granted to Mr. E. Ambrose, Sanitary Inspector, absent owing to ill-health.
  - Mr. C. P. Dias moved that the leave be granted. Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.
- 19. To sanction excess leave of 18 days over 30 days granted to Mr. W. B. A. Fernando, Clerk, Works Department, absent owing to ill-health.
  - Mr. C. P. Dias moved that the leave be granted. Mr. E. G. Jayewardene seconded.—Carried.
- 20. The City Analyst's report on town water for October, 1912, and the Municipal Bacteriologist's report on town water for the month of September, 1912, were laid on the table.
- 21. Progress Report No. 20 of the City Sanitation Engineer for October, 1912, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
- 22. Report of the Chief Resident Engineer of the Colombo Drainage Works for the month of September, 1912, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
