MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Criminal Procedure Code (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1913."

Addition of sub-section to section 256.

2 The following sub-section shall be added to section 256 of the principal Ordinance and shall be numbered (g):

(g) Persons for the time being holding any office or offices in the Public Service, to which His Excellency the Governor, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, may extend the privileges of this section.

It has been found that inconvenience is caused in the despatch of public business by public officers, particularly heads of departments, being summoned to serve on the jury. The object of this Bill is therefore to give the Governor power to exempt such officers as he may deem fit from serving as jurors.
