Coconuts : flowering and prospects of coconut are fair. Estimated crop in Hurulu and Kalagam palatas during the month was 2,400 nuts.

Health of people : fever is prevailing to some extent in the province. There were a few cases of measles at Galkulama.

Health of cattle : rinderpest is still prevailing in two tulanas in Hurulu palata, but the epidemic is on the decrease. Tanks : there is sufficient water in almost all the tanks.

#### PROVINCE OF UVA.

#### BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather: dry.

Paddy : fields are being ploughed and sown for maha cultivation.

Chenas: chena crops have been gathered.

Fruits and vegetables : fruit is scarce and dear. A moderate supply of chena vegetables is available.

Other products : the flowering and prospects of coconut are fair.

Health of the people : satisfactory, except for a few cases of fever and sore eyes.

Health of cattle : a few cases of rinderpest occurred in Kandukara korale of Buttala division. Hoof-and-mouth disease prevails in some parts of Yatikinda, Udukinda, and Bintenna divisions.

Price of staple products : rice, varies from Rs. 7 to Rs. 9 per bushel; kurakkan, from Re.  $1 \cdot 25$  to Rs.  $2 \cdot 50$  per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 10 to Rs. 15 per 100.

Rainfall:  $3 \cdot 15$  in. as registered at the observatory, Badulla.

PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

#### RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha crop has been harvested throughout the district. Fields are being prepared for yala cultivation. Dry grain: in Kuruwiti korale the perayal chenas have been sown. In Nawadun, Meda, and Kadawata and Kolonna the crops on chenas have been gathered.

Other products, coconuts: crops satisfactory.

Health of cattle : satisfactory, except that hoof-and-mouth disease prevails in some parts of Kuruwiti korale. Health of people : satisfactory, except that dysentery is prevalent in three wasams of Kuruwiti korale.


