Other products : (a) the flowering and prospects of coconuts good; (b) actual crop for the month, about 521,000 nuts.

*Conditions of the Sale of Ebony.*

1. Ebony will be put up for sale at a rate per ton, and bids not less than Rs. 5 at a time will be accepted.
2. Any person to whom a lot is knocked down must pay at once 25 per cent. of the value of the timber if required, and the balance within twenty days from date of sale.
