

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Paluwatta, Tibbotuwapolahena, Ambegawakoratuwa, &c., situate in the village of Ginneliya, in the Morawak korale of the Matara District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
