





Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Pitahewatta, situate in the village of Obadellagama, in the Mahapalata korale of the Udukinda division, in the Province of Uva, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903.
