The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for
general information :—An Ordinance to repeal "The Courts Ordinance, 1889," so far
as it relates to the Rank and Precedence of the
Chief Justice and Puisne Judges of the
Supreme Court.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal "The Courts Ordinance,
1889," so far as it relates to the rank and
precedence of the Chief Justice and Puisne Judges of the
Supreme Court: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of
Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Courts (Amend-
ment) Ordinance, No. of 1913."

Repeal.

2 The Ordinances specified in Schedule A hereto are hereby
repealed to the extent specified in the third column thereof.
