PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ARTHUR ELIBANK HAVELOCK, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS by "The Courts Ordinance, 1889," it is amongst other things enacted that Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court shall be holden by one of the Judges thereof for the Midland Circuit, three times at least at Kandy, and any other Sessions at such other places in such Circuit as the Governor, after previous consultation with the Judges, shall appoint:

And whereas it appears to Us expedient that a Criminal Session of the Supreme Court should be holden at Badulla, a place comprised in the Midland Circuit:

Now therefore know Ye that We, the said Governor, after previous consultation with the Judges, do direct and appoint that a Criminal Session of the Supreme Court shall be holden at Badulla, within the Midland Circuit, on or about Wednesday, the 20th day of April, 1892.

Given at Nuwara Eliya, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Sixth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-two.

Japan.—Yezo Island.—Fixed Light at Isharri River Entrance.—Stroganov Bay.

The British Admiralty has given notice (No. 34 of 1892) that on January 1, 1892, a light would be exhibited from a lighthouse erected at Isharri (Ishikari) river entrance, eastern shore of Stroganov bay.

Isharri light is a fixed white light, visible through an arc of 180°, or from the bearing of N. 49° E. to S. 49° W. It is elevated 48 ft. above the sea, and should be seen in clear weather from a distance of 6 miles.

The lighthouse, 40 ft. high, constructed of wood and hexagonal in shape, is painted black and white in horizontal bands.

(1859.) *Hokushu.—South Coast.—Nemoro Peninsula.—Sunken Reef near Habomai Island.*

John Will, commanding the Mitsui Bussan Kaisha's steamer Tsukushi Maru, reports that she touched on an unknown rock while approaching Habomai anchorage, S. E.

coast of Nemoro peninsula, from westward, October, 1891, and from it the following bearings were taken:—

Sukiushi zaki ... N. W. by W. ¼ W.
South end of Isomoshiri-jima ... N. E. by E.

At the time she (drawing 17 ft.) touched the lead gave 4½ fathoms on the starboard side, so that it must be a pinnacle, but its top or shallowest part was searched without success, as our least cast was 3 fathoms, and weather was bad.

China Sea.—Shanghai District.—Southern Entrance to the Yangtze.

Notice is hereby given that on account of alterations which have taken place in the bed of the river, as disclosed by a recent survey, the following changes have been made in the marking of the channel.

The lightship Kiutoan has been shifted to a position off the south-eastern end of Blockhouse shoal, from which the Kiutoan beacon bears S. 68½° W., distant about 3⅞ miles.

The Middle Ground Lower Buoy (No. 2 in the published List for 1891) has been shifted to a spot from which House Island surveying beacon bears N. 11° W., distant about 3⅞ miles, where it marks the port side of the channel entering. This buoy is now painted black, and surmounted by a black spherical cage.

The Middle Ground Upper Buoy (No. 3 in the published List for 1891) has been shifted to a spot from which Kiutoan beacon bears S. 12° W., distant about 2⅞ miles, where it marks the port side of the channel entering and the north-western end of the long tongue or shoal into which the former Middle Ground has developed. This buoy is painted black, and surmounted by a black cylindrical cage.

A red buoy, surmounted by a black spherical cage, to be known as the South-east Knoll Buoy, has been moored [with small Kiutoan beacon S. 87° W., distant about 2⅞ miles] off the south-easternmost of a line of knolls which have formed off the south-western side of Blockhouse shoal. This buoy marks the starboard side of the channel entering.

All bearings are magnetic.

Caution.

Vessels should not attempt to pass to the north-eastward of the Kiutoan lightship in her present position.

SEALED Tenders (in duplicate), marked on the envelopes "Tender for the purchase of the Right to Salve Drift Timber on the ——— River," will be received at the Colonial Secretary's Office up to noon on Monday, July 4, 1892, from persons willing to purchase the right to salve drift timber on such portions of each of the following rivers as are specified below, up to December 31, 1892:—

- The Kelani-ganga—below junction with the Sitawak-ganga.
The Kalu-ganga—below Nambapana.
The Bentota-ganga—below junction with the Pelawatta-ganga.
The Maha-oya—below Ambepussa railway bridge.

Separate tenders must be sent in for each river, and a lump sum be offered for the right to salve timber on each river.

The persons whose tenders are accepted will be entitled to all drift timber on their respective rivers, whether salvaged by themselves and their agents or by others. In the case of timber salvaged by others, salvage fees, as fixed by the Government Agent, Western Province, will have to be paid by the right-holders to the salvers.

The salvage of all timber must be reported by the right-holder to the Assistant Conservator of Forests, Western Province, who will give notice of its salvage as required by law. If it is not claimed within the prescribed time, it will become the property of the right-holder. If claimed, and the claim be proved, the right-holder will be entitled to 50 per cent. of the value of the timber as estimated by the Assistant Conservator of Forests and to salvage fees to be paid by the owners of the timber.

The whole of the money tendered for the purchase of the right must be paid at once on notification of acceptance of tender.

A formal license to salve timber will be given to each right-holder.

The tenders must be made on forms which will be supplied upon application at the Colombo Kachcheri, and no tender will be considered unless it is furnished on the recognised form.

A deposit of Rs. 50 will be required before any form of tender is issued; and should any person decline or delay payment of the purchase money after notification of acceptance of tender, such deposit will be forfeited to the Crown. All other deposits will be returned upon signature of a contract.

The Government reserves to itself the right, without question, of rejecting any or all tenders, and the right of accepting any portion of a tender.

REPORT FOR THE YEAR 1891.

THE Balance Sheet and Statements submitted herewith furnish full information as to the business transacted during the year 1891, and cannot fail to be considered most satisfactory.

The attached Statement of Particulars for the past ten Years shows a decided increase in 1891. Fewer accounts were closed, and a larger number of new accounts were opened than during the previous four years. The amount

deposited is the largest since 1883, and the total to credit of depositors on December 31, 1891, is the largest since the Bank was established.

The difficulty of finding secure investment for the funds entrusted to the Bank—at such rate of interest as may enable the Trustees and Managers to continue to depositors the same reasonable rate of interest as has been paid during the past years—has received serious consideration.

The Trustees and Managers were obliged to notify in December last that the rate of interest to be allowed to depositors during 1892 would be at 3 per cent. on accounts amounting to Rs. 1,000 and over, and 4 per cent. on accounts under Rs. 1,000.

The Trustees have, during the year 1891, refrained from further investment in Indian Government 4 per cent. paper, as they considered they were not justified in purchasing at a premium of 7 to 9 per cent.

The Government has again refused to cancel its order prohibiting Trustees lending on security of first class house property, which has led to accumulation of large sums in local banks pending opportunity to invest outside the Island on reasonable terms. The Trustees and Managers are of opinion that loans on first class house property would be a legitimate, safe, and advantageous investment under the restrictions which have always governed such loans.

The disadvantage which depositors in the Ceylon Savings Bank labour under, by not being permitted to remit their books, &c., free of postage, seems to have a prohibitory effect. To remit one rupee costs a villager 8 to 15 per cent. One rupee is not an unusual sum for a first deposit, and 15 per cent., which is the more general cost, is certainly a heavy, if not prohibitory, charge.

That first deposits are generally small is in some measure proved by the Table of Classification of Accounts, reference to which will show that the number of accounts open on December 31, 1891, under Rs. 5 was 2,849, an increase over 1890 of 866.

The oldest account now on the books of the Bank was opened in May, 1844.

MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

Minutes of Proceedings of a Meeting of the Municipal Council of Kandy held in the Kachcheri on Thursday, January 21, 1892, at 4 o'clock p.m.

Present.—Hon. P. A. Templer, Chairman; F. Vine, Esq.; Dr. F. Keyt; J. B. Siebel, Esq.; J. H. Sproule, Esq.; J. N. d'Esterre, Esq.; E. Beven, Esq.; F. van Langenberg, Esq.; B. de Alwis, Esq.

1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the regular Meeting held on December 12, and of a Special Meeting held on the same day, were read and confirmed.

2. As the accounts for 1891 had not been finally closed, the Chairman stated that the Statements of Receipts and Disbursements to end of 1891 were not ready, but the other statements usually submitted were laid on the table.

Resolved,—That all the statements be considered at one and the same time; that the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting be forwarded to Government as required by section 90 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance No. 7 of 1887.

In reply to a question the Secretary was instructed that it was not necessary to send for publication the Minutes of any Special Meeting, section 90 requiring only the Minutes of Regular Meetings.

3. Read letter No. 422 of January 19, from the Superintendent of Police, stating that steps will be taken to put a stop to the nuisance complained of by the Health Officer as existing at the Police Barracks in Ward street.

4. Read letter No. 1 dated January 12, from the Clerk to the Executive Council, intimating that the Governor in Executive Council has approved of the Municipal Council levying taxes during 1892 at the rates specified in the Schedule entered in Minutes of the Special Meeting held on December 12.

5. Read letter No. 3 dated January 16, from the Clerk to the Executive Council, intimating the sanction by His Excellency the Governor in Executive Council of the levy by the Kandy Municipality of an assessment rate of 5 per cent. on the annual value of premises liable during 1892.

6. Under section 88 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887 the Council proceeded to appoint a Standing Committee.

On the motion of the Chairman, it was unanimously resolved that the Standing Committee consist of four Members as before, in addition to the Chairman.

The Meeting then proceeded to ballot for Members of the Standing Committee. On the votes being scrutinised the Chairman declared the following Councillors to have been elected Members to form, together with the Chairman, the Standing Committee:—Messrs. F. Vine, J. H. Sproule, E. Beven, and F. van Langenberg.

7. The Chairman requested that the consideration of the report of the Special Committee, appointed on April 18, to inquire and report on the Establishment, and which had been circulated, be deferred until next Meeting, to afford him an opportunity of submitting a Minute thereon.

This was agreed to.

8. In pursuance of notice it was proposed by Mr. E. Beven, seconded by Dr. F. Keyt, "that the attention of Government be called to the present state of the lake with a view to financial help in clearing and removing the accumulation of silt that now makes it unsightly, and a source of danger sanitarily."

Resolved,—That a copy of the resolution be forwarded to Government with a covering letter from the Chairman.

9. In accordance with notice it was proposed by Mr. Sproule, seconded by Mr. J. N. d'Esterre, "that the Council desires to record its regret at the retirement of the Hon. R. W. D. Moir, and to express its sense of the valuable services rendered by him as Chairman of the Council during the three years he presided at this Board."

On being put to the Meeting this resolution was unanimously carried.

It was resolved that a copy of the resolution be forwarded to Mr. Moir.

10. Read report by the Secretary with regard to the emptying of the reservoir and consequent stoppage of the usual water supply for the town in consequence of an accident to the lifting rod of the valve: and report as to the action taken by him to remedy the defects in the lifting rod.

Resolved,—That the action of the Secretary be approved of.

Resolved further,—That the Secretary be instructed to have a drawing made of the rod, in order that a new one may be constructed in readiness should a similar mishap occur again.
