





FINAL ORDERS.

Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1908," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Kalukele (reservation for dola), Kalukele, situate in the village of Madabawita, in the Udugaha pattu of Hapitigam korale of the Negombo District, in the Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."






