"Improvements to Railway Block Instruments, and the like."

*Abstract*:—The inventor states:—All railway block instruments at present in use are actuated either by direct or alternating currents. It would provide increased safety if such instruments were arranged so as to be actuated only by a combination of different kinds of current.

The object of the invention is contained in the above statement. The manner in which it is carried out cannot be stated without copying the whole Specification.

The claim is:—

(1) A railway block instrument, or the like arranged substantially as described and illustrated so that it can be actuated only by a plurality of currents of different kinds received from the distant station, one or more being, and one or more not being, a direct current.

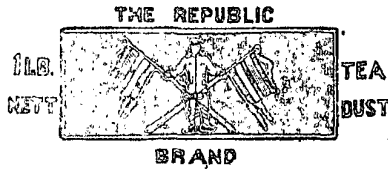
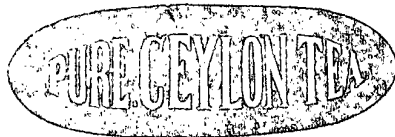
