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**A**N application for the sale of a Crown land of 1,200 acres under Kaláwewa tank, North-Central Province, to Mr. Simon de Silva, of Makavita, otherwise than by public auction, has been received and is under consideration.

1. The purchaser shall pay to Government as purchase amount Rs. 10 per acre in four equal annual instalments; in default of payment of any such instalment the land shall revert to the Crown.
2. The purchaser shall pay costs of the survey of the land at the rate of Rs. 2.50 per acre, calculated on the total acreage.
3. In accordance with sections 47 and 48 of Ordinance No. 23 of 1889, the purchaser shall pay interest on the cost of restoration and upkeep of Kaláwewa, at the rate of Re. 1 per acre, on all of the land that may be decided by Government to have been benefited by Kaláwewa or connected works.
4. The purchaser shall contribute, in accordance with section 51 of Ordinance No. 23 of 1889, towards the maintenance of the irrigation works, at the rate of 10 cents per acre per annum, for such portions of the land as may become irrigable under Kaláwewa or connected works.
5. The purchaser shall pay Rs. 2.50 per acre on account of all timber standing on the land,—the timber to be at his disposal.
6. The purchaser shall execute a bond stipulating, with a penalty for non-performance, that he will open for cultivation annually not less than 100 acres.

N.B.—The Government does not guarantee a supply of water.

### EASTERN CADETSHIPS.

#### Notice.

An Open Competitive Examination for not fewer than two Cadetships\* will be held in London on November 10, 1892, and following days, under the Regulations dated August 19, 1891, a copy of which is hereunto annexed.

A Preliminary Examination will be held in London, Edinburgh, and Dublin on November 1, 1892.

\* \* No person will be admitted to the Preliminary Examination from whom the Secretary, Civil Service Commission, has not received on or before October 18, 1892, an application on the prescribed form, of which a copy marked I. is herewith sent.

The orders for admission to the Preliminary Examination will be posted on October 25 to the address given on the form of application. An order for admission to the Competitive Examination will be posted on November 5 to all candidates who pass at this Preliminary Examination. The orders will, in each case, contain instructions as to the time and place at which candidates will be required to attend, and as to the manner in which the fee is to be paid.

Candidates who have already passed a Preliminary Examination and desire to be admitted to the forthcoming Competitive Examination in London should fill up the form marked II. This form must be received by the Secretary, Civil Service Commission, not later than October 18. The orders will in these cases also be posted on November 5.

### Examinations for Eastern Cadetships—viz., for Cadetships in the Civil Services of Hongkong, Ceylon, and the Straits Settlements.

[The next Examination for Eastern Cadetships will be held under these Regulations. Alterations may be made for any subsequent Examination.]

1. The Cadets, who must be natural-born British subjects, are selected by Open Competitive Examination held by the Civil Service Commissioners, to whom all inquiries on the subject should be addressed.

The examinations for these appointments will, as a rule, be held in the Autumn of those years in which vacancies have occurred in the Civil Services of Hongkong, Ceylon, and the Straits Settlements; and the successful candidates will be allowed, in their order, to choose amongst the vacancies in the three Colonies.

2. Candidates must be between the ages of 21 and 24 on the First day of August in the year in which the examination is held, and must satisfy the Civil Service Commissioners that they are duly qualified in respect of health and character. They must be of sound constitution, possessed of good sight, and physically qualified for service in tropical climates, and they will be called upon to undergo a medical examination to test these points.

3. No candidate will be admitted to the competition who has not previously passed, to the satisfaction of the Civil Service Commissioners, a Preliminary Examination in Handwriting, Orthography, and Arithmetic (including Vulgar and Decimal Fractions).

4. The fees required from candidates are £1 for the Preliminary and £5 for the Competitive Examination.

5. The heads of the Competitive Examination are as follows :—

#### A.—Obligatory.

a. Latin.

b. One of the following languages :—Greek, French, German, Italian. The qualifying test for a and b will be translation from the language, but marks will be given for translation into it, and, in the case of the Modern languages, for colloquial proficiency.

c. English composition, including Précis writing.

#### B.—Optional.

d. Pure Mathematics, viz., Euclid I.—IV. and VI.; Algebra, including the binomial theorem; Trigonometry, including the solution of triangles; Analytical Geometry (elementary) and Mixed Mathematics, including Statics and Dynamics treated without the Differential Calculus.

e. (1) Modern Geography and (2) Ancient and Modern History. The examination in History will be confined to certain periods, to be prescribed for each examination. ‡

\* The existing vacancies are in the Straits Settlements.

† If an examination is held in 1892, it will take place in the month of October or November.

‡ For the examination of November, 1892, the periods will be :—

Ancient History { (a) Greek History, from B.C. 600 to the end of the Peloponnesian War (B.C. 404).  
(b) Roman History, from B.C. 390 to the death of Augustus (A.D. 14).  
Modern History, from 1625 to 1815.

- f. The elements of Constitutional and International Law, and Political Economy.  
 g. Geology, Civil Engineering, and Surveying.  
 h. Any two languages included under head *b* which have not been taken up as obligatory.

Every candidate must show a competent knowledge of the obligatory subjects, and may select any two of the optional subjects.

## GOVERNMENT OF JAPAN.—No. 80.

*Keramui-misaki Lighthouse and Fog Bell, South-western extreme of Kunashiri Island, Hokkaido.*

Notice is hereby given that a lighthouse has been erected at the south-western extreme of Kunashiri Island, Hokkaido, the light of which will be exhibited on the night of May 15, 1892, and every night thereafter from sunset until sunrise.

According to the Japanese Admiralty Chart No. 93, the position of the lighthouse is approximately in latitude  $43^{\circ} 40'$  north and in longitude  $145^{\circ} 31'$  east of Greenwich.

The lighthouse is built of wood, octagonal in shape, and is painted with black and white horizontal bands, and 40 ft. high from the base to the centre of the lantern.

The light will be a fifth order revolving light, showing a white flash once every 15 seconds. Its arc of illumination will be  $301^{\circ} 40'$  between the bearings of N.  $46^{\circ} 50'$  E. and N.  $11^{\circ} 30'$  W. The bearings are true, and as observed from the lighthouse.

The elevation of the light above the sea will be 45 ft., and in clear weather it will be seen from a distance of 12 nautical miles.

During foggy or thick weather a fog bell of 387 lb. will be rung at the rate of 12 strokes per minute.

No light will be exhibited nor bell sounded during the months of January and February every year.

## BENGAL.—No. 82.

*India, West—Bombay Coast—Alterations in Buoyage, &c.—Bombay Harbour.*

Notice to Mariners No. 137 of 1892, issued by the British Admiralty, is republished:—

The following information, dated March 1, 1892, relative to alterations in buoyage, &c., in Bombay harbour has been received from Lieutenant and Commander H. Preedy, H. M. S. Redbreast:—

1. The depth over Raleigh rock has been reported to be increased by blasting to 26 ft., and the buoy previously marking this danger has therefore been withdrawn.

2. A buoy named Third Troopship Buoy has been moored with south beacon bearing W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  S., and Dolphin lighthouse N. by W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  W., distant 3 cables.

3. Flagstaff shoal buoy has been moved about three-quarters of a cable eastward of its previous position, and now lies in about 23 ft. water.

4. North patch buoy will be withdrawn on May 1, 1892, as the least depth for about 2 cables inside it is now 10 ft.

NOTE.—Quarantine anchorage in Bombay harbour is now defined as follows:—By an imaginary line drawn from Prongs lighthouse through Sunk rock lighthouse, and at the distance of  $1\frac{1}{4}$  to 2 miles from the last-named lighthouse, in depths of 32 to 36 ft., with Dolphin lighthouse bearing from N. W. to W. N. W.

The depths given are at low water spring tides.
