## LAND SALES IN THE SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

NOTICE is hereby given that on Tuesday, February 24, 1914, at 1 P.M., the Government Agent, Southern. Province, will put up to auction, at his office at the Galle Kachcheri, the right to dig lor plumbago in the undermentioned Crown lands in the Galle District, and support to contain plumbago. for a period of five years on the following conditions:—

(a) The lease will include the right of mining for plumbago only, and will be for a period of five years only at the yearly ground rent of Rs. 10 per acre per annum, and subject to the covenants and conditions as sanctioned by Government, copy of which can be obtained at the Kachcheri. The highest bidder for the lease of the above mentioned allotment shall be the purchaser, provided that the price offered by him amounts at least to the upset price as stated against each lot in column 4.

(b) No bidding shall be finally accepted unless the person making the same shall, on being declared the highest bidder, immediately pay to the Government Agent a deposit of 10 per cent. on the amount of each bidding, whether he has made a previous deposit or not, and also unless the said person shall, on being declared the highest bidder as aforesaid, sign the above mentioned conditions of sale.

(c) The purchaser shall pay to the Government Agent within one month of the date of sale the balance of the

purchase money, and in failure thereof the purchase shall be considered void, and deposit of 10 per cent., together with any other sum paid on account of the land, shall be forfeited.

(d) On payment to the Government Agent within the time specified of the whole of the purchase money, the Government Agent will grant to the purchaser a lease in the approved form, and the purchaser shall at the same time execute and deliver to the Government Agent a duplicate of such lease.

(e) Should any error or mistake hereafter appear in the description and admeasurement of the said land, the purchaser will not be entitled to claim any compensation or abatement of the price in respect thereof.

(f) The fee for the preparation of the lease is 4 per cent. of purchase money, not exceeding Rs. 20, and must be paid on day of sale.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy, maha: the plants are thriving well. Yala: the crop has been reaped and threshed. Dry grain : nil.

Dry gram: nu. Other products : oranges, pineapples, breadfruits, jak, and vegetables are scarce. Prices of staple products : imported rice is sold from Rs. 4:50 to Rs. 6 per bushel according to quality. Price of coconuts varies between Rs. 65 and Rs. 75 per thousand. Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a fair harvest is expected. Rainfall : there was a good deal of rain during the month. Health of inhabitants : not very satisfactory ; dysentery prevailed to some extent. Cholera broke out in Peliyagoda, Colombo, and Negombo.

Paddy : plants are in ears.

Tobacco : planting is going on. Coconut : condition of crops medium.

Fishery : medium ; large quantity are sold for preparing salt fish to be exported to outstations.

Health of people : a few cases of dengue fever and measles in the town ; fever prevails to a large extent in Koddiyar pattu, but not fatal ; a few cases of fever in Kaddukkulari West.

Health of cattle : satisfactory.

Prices of staple articles: paddy, Re. 1.50 to Rs. 2 per bushel; rice (imported), Rs. 5.88 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 3.50 to Rs. 5.32.

#### PUTTALAM AND CHILAW DISTRICTS.

### Paddy : paddy sown for maha is earing and thriving well.

Dry grain : maha cultivation is growing well. Other products, including coconuts : flowering and prospects of coconut are satisfactory. The crop in the two districts for the month is estimated at 18,050,758 nuts. Galas have been planted with tobacco plants. Vegetables scarce. Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 4:50 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; paddy, Re. 1:50 to Rs. 2 per bushel ; dry grain, Re. 1:25 to Rs. 2 per bushel; peas, Rs. 450 to Rs. 550 per bushel; salt, 4 cents to 5 cents per pound; cassava, Re. 1.50 per cwt.; coconut, 7 cents to 9 cents per nut.

Rainfall of the month : Puttalam, 6.61 in. ; Chilaw, 3.98 in.

Harvest prospects generally : good.

Health of inhabitants : fever prevails to some extent, Some cases of dysentery found here and there. Usual parangi in Demala hatpattu.

Health of cattle : cattle disease is on the decrease.

#### NORTH-CENTRAL PROVINCE.

#### ANURADHAPURA DISTRICT.

Weather : wet.

Rainfall : the registered rainfall at Anuradhapura during the month was 11.41 in.

Paddy : in Kalagam palata and Tamankaduwa district the fields are being prepared for cultivation ; in Hurulu and Nuwaragam palatas fields are in young plants. Kurakkan : kura kan chenas are being sown.

Gingelly : there has been no gingelly cultivation during the month.

Coconuts : flowering and prospects of coconut fair. The estimated crop during the month was about 10,700 nuts. Health of people : fair. Fever prevails in Nuwaragam and Hurulu palatas and Tamankaduwa district. A few cases of dysentery were reported from Hurulu palata.

Health of cattle : satisfactory. There is no rinderpest in the Province. Tanks : all the village tanks are nearly full.

## PROVINCE OF UVA. BADULLA DISTRICT.

Weather: generally wet, especially on the 16th of the month, when there was a cyclonic rain storm, which caused considerable damages to anicuts, roads, fields, and gardens. Paddy : fields being ploughed for yala cultivation. Irrigation elas which suffered from the floods are being repaired

and cleared.

Chenas: chenas have been sown.

Fruits and vegetables : fruit is scarce and dear. A moderate supply of vegetables is available.

Other products : the flowering and prospects of the coconut are fair.

Health of the people : not satisfactory. Malarial fever exists in every division. There are also a few cases of chickenpox, measles, sore-eyes, and dysentery.

Health of cattle : good.

Prices of staple products : rice, varies from Rs. 6 50 to Rs. 8 per bushel ; kurakkan, from Re. 1 50 to Rs. 2 50 per bushel; coconuts, from Rs. 10 to Rs. 15 per 100 nuts.

Rainfall: 23.31 in. as registered at the observatory.

### PROVINCE OF SABARAGAMUWA.

RATNAPURA DISTRICT.

Paddy : maha fields are in plants. In some parts fields are being prepared for sowing.

Dry grain : el-paddy chenas are in plants and in some parts ripening. Kurakkan chenas are blossoming.

Other products-coconuts : prospects fair.

Health of people : fever and dysentery were prevalent in some parts of the district.

Health of cattle : satisfactory, except at Uggalkaltota, where hoof-and-mouth disease was prevalent. Rainfall : there was heavy rain during the month. Prices of food stuffs : rice (imported), Rs. 6 to Rs. 7 50 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 4 to Rs. 6 per bushel; kurakkan, Re. 1 50 to Rs. 2 50 per bushel; amu, 75 cents to Re. 1 75 per bushel; paddy, Re. 1 75 to Rs. 2 per bushel; salt, 10 cents to 24 cents per measure ; coconuts, Rs. 7 to Rs. 12 per 100.
