#### SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

#### HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation : paddy plants are in an advanced stage of growth.

Fine grain : maha crops are maturing. Weather : maximum temperature,  $82 \cdot 8^{\circ}$  ; minimum temperature,  $72 \cdot 6^{\circ}$  ; rainfall,  $8 \cdot 58$  in.

Health of people : fever prevails in some parts of the district.

Health of cattle : satisfactory. Food supply : Coast rice, Rs. 5 28 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; country rice, Rs. 5 28 to Rs. 5 50 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 24 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2 40 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 70 to Rs. 80 per 1,000 ; plantain bunches Rs. 50 to Rs. 70 per 100 ; Indian corn, Re. 1 50 per 100 ; pumpkins, Rs. 35 per 100 ; sweet potatoes, Rs. 2 per cwt.
