THE following Specification has been accepted:—

No. 1,304 of October 31, 1912.

Montagu Kelway Bamber,

"Killing weeds and parasitic growths on trees or bushes."

Abstract:—

The nature of the invention is described in the claims as follows:—

(1) Killing weeds and parasitic growths on trees or bushes by applying heat to such growing weeds or to parasitic growths, or insects on trees, plants, or bushes.

(2) Killing weeds and parasitic growths on trees or bushes by an apparatus containing an inflammable liquid served into a receptacle A in figure part of such apparatus and the pumping of air into such receptacle, so that the liquid therein being under pressure from such air makes the hot flame issuing from the nozzle of the burner attached to the receptacle by a metal tube or pipe continuous substantially as described in the drawing and specification.
