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### DRAFT ORDINANCES.

#### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

**An Ordinance to declare the Law of the Colony with reference to the effect of War.**

Preamble.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to declare the law of the Colony with reference to the effect of war: Be it therefore declared and enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

**1** This Ordinance may be cited as "The Effect of War Ordinance, No. of 1914."

What law to govern questions relating to the effect of war.

**2** All questions, whether arising before or after the passing of this Ordinance, which relate to the effect of war upon legal rights, remedies, immunities, duties, liabilities, and obligations, shall be determined in accordance with the law by which such questions would for the time being be determined in England.

#### *Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

THIS Ordinance is introduced, with the concurrence of the Judges of the Supreme Court, with a view to settling the law to be applied in determining questions arising out of the effect of war on legal rights and obligations, and in particular such questions as the status of enemy subjects, the right of capture at sea, and the powers of the military authorities.

**2.** It is thought urgently necessary that in these matters the law of the Colony should be in harmony with that of the mother country.

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance relating to the Exportation of the  
Necessaries of War.

Preamble.	WHEREAS it is expedient to provide in certain cases for the prohibition of the exportation of the necessaries of war: Be it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:
Short title and retrospective operation.	1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Necessaries of War Exportation Ordinance, No. of 1914," and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the Fifth day of August, 1914.
Power of Governor to prohibit exportation of necessaries of war.	2 The Governor may, by Proclamation published in the <i>Government Gazette</i> , either absolutely or subject to such limitations and conditions as may be defined in the Proclamation, prohibit the exportation from Ceylon of any of the goods enumerated in the schedule to this Ordinance.
Penalties.	3 If any person shall in breach of any such Proclamation export or attempt to export any of the goods therein named or indicated he shall be guilty of an offence, and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand rupees, and to imprisonment of either description for a period not exceeding twelve months, and the goods in respect of which the offence was committed shall be forfeited.
Repeal.	4 "The Exportation of Arms Ordinance, 1900," is hereby repealed.

## SCHEDULE.

Arms.

Ammunition.

Military or naval stores.

Any article which the Governor may judge capable of being converted into or made useful for the purpose of arms, ammunition, or military or naval stores.

Provisions or any sort of victual which may be used as food for men or for animals employed in warfare.

Any other article, of which the Governor in time of war or apprehended war may deem it expedient to prohibit or limit the export, on the ground that such export would otherwise be liable to increase the resources of His Majesty's enemies, or restrict the supplies of His Majesty's forces, or of the civil population of the Colony or any other part of His Majesty's dominions.

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

THE object of this Ordinance is to replace "The Exportation of Arms Ordinance, 1900," by a more comprehensive and effective measure.

2. The Ordinance referred to permits the Governor to impose a limited restriction on the exportation of arms and military and naval stores, so as to prevent these articles reaching the enemy through neutral ports. It is necessary that the powers of the Governor should be extended so as to include the total prohibition of the exportation of such articles (as, for example, coal), and also that his powers of prohibition should be extended to food stuffs, so as to prevent the supplies both of His Majesty's forces and the civil population being restricted. Such powers of total prohibition exist in English law.

3. Attention is drawn to the following points:—

- (a) The schedule, which enumerates the articles to which the Ordinance applies, has been made as comprehensive as possible.
- (b) The operation of the Ordinance is ante-dated to the commencement of the present war.
- (c) The power of prohibition is conferred upon the Governor, and not upon the Governor in Executive Council, to allow of action being taken promptly, and to obviate the necessity of circulating papers at a time of emergency.
