Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 7 of 1914.

An Ordinance further to amend Ordinance No. 11 of 1842, intituled "An Ordinance to provide for a Church in Kandy."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend Ordinance No. 11 of 1842, intituled "An Ordinance to provide for a Church in Kandy": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Kandy Church (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 7 of 1914," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance.

Amendment of section 10.

2 The words "to convene a general meeting, to whom it shall be competent to authorize the said trustees" in lines 32 and 33 of section 10 of the principal Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**No. 8 of 1914.**

An Ordinance further to amend "The Land Acquisition Ordinance, 1876."

ROBERT CHALMERS.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Land Acquisition Ordinance, 1876," hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Land Acquisition (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 8 of 1914," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance.

Substitution of a new section for section 47 of the principal Ordinance.

2 For section 47 of the principal Ordinance, which was added by section 2 of "The Land Acquisition (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 25 of 1912," the following section shall be substituted:

Acquisition by way of gift.

47. If in any case in which proceedings have been taken for the acquisition of any land under this Ordinance for a public purpose, the person claiming to be the owner of the land desires to make a free gift of the land to His Majesty for the said purpose and to renounce all claim to compensation therefor, a record in writing to that effect duly signed by such person in the presence of the officer acquiring the land on behalf of the Crown, or in the presence of any person authorized by him in writing in that behalf, shall be sufficient to vest the land in His Majesty absolutely, and shall have the same effect for the purpose of barring claims for compensation at the instance of any person whomsoever as payment of compensation under section 36.

**No. 9 of 1914.**

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 14 of 1878, intituled "An Ordinance to amend 'The Weights and Measures Ordinance, 1876.'"

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Ordinance No. 14 of 1878, intituled "An Ordinance to amend 'The Weights and Measures Ordinance, 1876'": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Weights and Measures (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 9 of 1914."

New section 7.

Penalty on use and possession of false and unstamped weights and measures.

2 The following section shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 6, and shall be numbered 7 :

7 Any person buying, selling, dealing in, despatching, carrying, delivering, or receiving by weight or measure, who shall use, or in whose store, shop, boutique, house, stall, or standing place shall be found, any weight or measure representing or intended to represent or be used as any of the weights or measures mentioned in the schedule to "The Weights and Measures Ordinance, 1876," and not being in conformity with the standards established under that Ordinance, or not stamped as provided by that Ordinance, or any false or unequal balance, steelyard, or weighing machine, or any striker which is not in conformity with the requirements of the fifth section of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable to fine not exceeding fifty rupees, and on a second or subsequent offence to a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees, or to simple or rigorous imprisonment for any term not exceeding three months, or to both.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 10 of 1914.

An Ordinance to provide for the Publication of a Revised Edition of the Legislative Enactments of this Island.

ROBERT CHALMERS.

Preamble.

WHEREAS a revised edition of the Legislative Enactments of this Island has been prepared by Thomas Forrest Garvin, Esquire, Advocate of the Supreme Court of Ceylon and Acting Solicitor-General, and Edward Beaumont Fraser Sueter, Esquire, a Member of the Ceylon Civil Service, and it is expedient to legalize the publication of the same : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance shall be cited for all purposes as "The Revised Edition Ordinance, No. 10 of 1914."

Legalization of new edition.

2 Every copy of the said revised edition shall be stamped with the Seal of the Island, and, subject to the exception in the next following section, the copies so stamped shall be deemed to be and shall be, without any question whatsoever, in all courts of justice the only proper Statute Book of the Island up to the date of the latest of the Ordinances contained therein.

Provision with regard to certain Ordinances.

3 Provided that "The Civil Procedure Code, 1889," "The Courts of Requests Amendment Ordinance, 1895," and Ordinance No. 5 of 1896, intituled "An Ordinance to enable one Judge of the Supreme Court to hear all pending Appeals from District Courts which relate to matters not exceeding Three Hundred Rupees," though not included in the three volumes of the said edition, shall continue in force.

Effect of Ordinance on enactments which had not come into operation.

4 Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed as bringing into operation any of the enactments included in the said revised edition before the date at which such enactment, if it had not been so included, would have come into operation.

No. 11 of 1914.

An Ordinance to amend "The Mines and Machinery Protection Ordinance, 1896."

ROBERT CHALMERS.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Mines and Machinery Protection Ordinance, 1896," in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Mines and Machinery Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1914."

Substitution of new section 3.

2 For section 3 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted:

Notice of intention to open mine.

3 (1) If any person intends to open, work, or use any mine, he shall, one calendar month before commencing to open, work, or use such mine, furnish the Government Agent of the province within which such mine is situated with a declaration in writing containing the following particulars:

- (a) The name and boundaries of the land in which the mine is to be opened, worked, or used;
- (b) The nature of the right of the applicant to open, work, or use the mine on such land; and
- (c) The name or names and residence or residences of himself and of the person or persons under whose management or superintendence the mine is intended to be opened, worked, or used.

(2) If such person ceases to have an interest in such mine, or if any person or persons other than those named in the declaration shall be entrusted with the management or superintendence of such mine, such person shall forthwith make a further declaration thereof to the Government Agent.

Substitution of a new sub-section (c) for sub-section (c) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

3 For sub-section (c) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section shall be substituted:

- (c) Keeping mines, factories, and their surroundings in a clean and sanitary condition.

Substitution of a new sub-section (h) for sub-section (h) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

4 For sub-section (h) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section shall be substituted :

(h) The reporting to the Government Agent of the province, and to the Inspector of Mines and Factories, by the owner, superintendent, manager, or person in charge of any mine or factory, of any loss of life or any personal injury to any person employed in any mine or factory by reason of any accident or mishap at such mine or factory ; and

No. 12 of 1914.

An Ordinance further to amend "The Police Ordinance, 1865."

ROBERT CHALMERS.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Police Ordinance, 1865" : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Police (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 12 of 1914."

Repeal.

2 Section 73 A added to the principal Ordinance by "The Police (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 17 of 1912," is hereby repealed

Amendment of section 73.

3 The following new paragraph shall be added to section 73 of the principal Ordinance :

For the purposes of this section an article shall be deemed to be in the possession of a person if he knowingly has it in the actual possession of any other person, or in any house, building, lodging, apartment, field, or place, open or enclosed, whether occupied by himself or not, and whether the same is so had for his own use or benefit or for the use or benefit of another.

New section 73 A.

4 The following section shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 73 :

Penalty on traffic in Government property.

73 A (1) Every person who—

- (a) Buys, exchanges, takes in pawn, detains, or receives from a police officer or any person acting on his behalf on any pretence whatever ; or
- (b) Solicits or entices any police officer to sell, exchange, pawn, or give away ; or
- (c) Assists or acts for a police officer in selling, exchanging, pawning, or making away with any Government property—

shall, unless he proves either that he acted in ignorance of the same being Government property or of the person with whom he dealt being or acting for a police officer, or that the same was sold by order of the Government or some competent authority, be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees, or to imprisonment not exceeding three months.

(2) A person found committing an offence against this section may be apprehended without a warrant, and it shall be lawful for any police officer, authorized in writing in that behalf by a Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent of Police, to search without a warrant any place where he has reasonable cause to suspect there is any property with respect to which such an offence has been committed.
