COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Yala: the paddy plants are thriving well.
Maha: some fields are now being ploughed and others sown.
Dry grain: a few chenas have been sown with kurakkan in Hewagam korale, Hapitigam korale, and Siyane Korale
East. Other products: (a) flowering and prospects of coconuts good; (b) fruits are scarce, and vegetables can be had at moderate prices.
Remarks on harvest prospects: satisfactory.
Prices of staple products: (a) imported rice is sold from Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bushel; (b) coconuts can be had from Rs. 40 to Rs. 60 per 1,000.
Rainfall: there has been a few showers during the month.
