## FINAL ORDERS.

# Kurunegala S. O. No. 783.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Karandapotanehena, situate in the village of Karandapotana, in the Kiniyama korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

And whereas (1) William Dunuwila on behalf of (a) Cyril Dunuwila, (b) Eddie Nugawela, (c) Hugh Nugawela, (d) Malikka Nugawela, (e) Baby Nugawela, minors, and also on behalf of (f) Lionel Dunuwila, and (g) Anula Nugawela made claim thereto, and whereas (2) Timbirigahakande Helagedara Rambandiya, (3) Dodangollewatta Tissahamy, (4) Timbirigahakande Pahalagedara Dilinguwa, (5) Maddamawattegedara Mudalihamy, (6) Polwatte Gammandi withdrew claim as they only claimed as tenants of the aforesaid 1st claimant William Dunuwila; and whereas (7) Weliwattegedara Banda, (8) Monarawanegedara Kiriwante, (9) Dambagoddewatte Ratnaike, (10) Kandamullegedara Bandi, and (11) ditto Gamandi made claim to lot 46; and whereas the said 1st claimant, as duly appointed representative of the minors (a) Cyril Dunuwila. (b) Eddie Nugawela, (c) Hugh Nugawela, (d) Malikka Nugawela, (e) Baby Nugawela came to an agreement in writing dated March 15, 1913, with Harry Chambers Toller, Special Officer, whereby he, in consideration of the Settlement Officer settling as private otherwise than under the Waste Lands Ordinances, in his settlement of Alanmulla village, block survey preliminary plan 166, lots 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, and 70, and the said minors being declared along with (f) Lionel Dunuwila and (g) Anula Nugawela, (i.) the owners of lots 46A, 46B, 46C, 46B, 46E, 46F, 46G, 46H, 46I, 46J, 46U, 46V, 46W, 46Y, 46Z, 46AA, 46AC, 63, 71A, and 71C aggregating in extent 55 acres and 32 perches in the same block survey preliminary plan, and covered by Waste Lands Ordinance Notice No. 2,907; (ii.) the purchasers of lots 46AB, 46AD, 46AE, 46AF, 71B, 71D, and 71E aggregating in extent 50 acres 3 roods and 12 perches in the same block survey preliminary plan, for which a sum of Rs. 500 has been paid to the Special Officer, withdrew claim to the remainder of the lands; and whereas (f) Lionel Dunuwila, (g) Anula Nugawela came to an agreement in writing with Harry Chambers Toller, Special Officer, dated July 4, 1913, of the same tenor; and whereas the said 7th claimant came to an agreement in writing with John Still, Special Officer, dated June 17, 1909, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of 5 acres more or less of lot 46, now shown as lot 46T in block survey preliminary plan 166, for which a sum of Rs. 37 50 has been paid to the Special Officer; and whereas the said 8th claimant and John George Fraser, Special Officer came to an agreement in writing, dated April 17, 1909, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of 3 acres more or less and 1 acre more or less of lot 46 now shown as lots 46P and 46S in block survey preliminary plan 166, for which a sum of Rs. 30 has been paid to the Special Officer; and whereas the said 9th claimant and John George Fraser, Special Officer came to an agreement in writing dated April 17, 1909, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of I acre more or less of lot 46, now shown as lot 460 in block survey preliminary plan 166, for which a sum of Rs. 7.50 has been paid to the Special Officer; and whereas the said 10th claimant and John George Fraser, Special Officer, came to an agreement in writing dated April 18, 1909, whereby in consideration of his son Kundamullegedara Appuhamy being declared the purchaser of 3 acres more or less of lot 46 for a sum of Rs. 22.50, which was to be paid to the Government Agent at Badulla, on or before June 17, 1909, failed to make the aforesaid payment; and whereas the said 11th claimant and John George Fraser, Special Officer, came to an agreement in writing dated April 17, 1909, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of 1 acre more or less of lot 46, now shown as lot 46R, for which a sum of Rs. 7 50 has been paid to the Special Officer, withdrew their claims to the remainder of the lands, I, Harry Chambers Toller, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on April 30, 1914, order and declare under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said lands, as more fully described herein below, are the property of the Crown.




