In the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir Robert Chalmers, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

NOW Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, in the exercise of the powers vested in Us by section 13 of the Volunteer Ordinance, No. 8 of 1910, do hereby call out for active service the following portion of a corps of the Ceylon Volunteer Force:—

D, G, H, I, N, P, and R Companies of the Ceylon Light Infantry.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Sixth day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Fourteen.
