GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

ORDER by His Excellency the Governor under the Order of the Queen in Council of October 26, 1896.

ALL German subjects who shall arrive or shall have arrived in the Colony on or after the First day of August, 1914, and who shall seek to land or shall have landed therein (unless before so arriving they shall have obtained the express permission of the Governor to land in Ceylon), are hereby ordered to quit the shores of the Colony, and the Police are hereby authorized to arrest all persons refusing to obey this Order, and for the purpose of their departure to put them on board any ship or boat.

This Order extends to all German-speaking persons who shall fail to satisfy the Police by documentary evidence that they are not German subjects.
