In the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir Robert Chalmers, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Vice-Admiral of Ceylon.

NOW Ye that We, the Governor and Vice-Admiral of Ceylon, being satisfied thereof by information received by Us, do hereby declare that war has broken out between His Most Gracious Majesty and the Emperor of Austria and King of Hungary.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Thirteenth day of August, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Fourteen.
