PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

In the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir ROBERT CHALMERS, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

ROBERT CHALMERS.

KNOW Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, in pursuance of "The Necessaries of War Exportation Ordinance, No. 19 of 1914," do hereby prohibit the exportation from Ceylon of the article specified in the schedule hereto to the extent in the said schedule specified:—

SCHEDULE.

<i>Prohibited Article.</i>	<i>Extent of Prohibition.</i>
Raw rubber	To all foreign ports in Europe and on the Black Sea and Mediterranean Sea, except Spanish, Portuguese, French, and Belgian ports, and except Russian ports other than Baltic Sea ports.

Given at Colombo, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Twelfth day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Fourteen.
