## DRAFT ORDINANCES.

### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

#### An Ordinance to amend "The Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Ordinance, 1898."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Ordinance, 1898": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance shall be cited as "The Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1914."

Amendment of section 5 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 5 of the principal Ordinance shall be amended by the substitution of the expression "the thirty-first day of December" for the expression "the thirtieth day of June."

Amendment of sub-section (5) of section 6 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Sub-section (5) of section 6 of the principal Ordinance shall be amended by the substitution of the word "January" for the word "August," and the substitution of the expression "the thirty-first day of December" for the expression "the thirtieth June."

#### Statement of Objects and Reasons.

UNDER "The Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Ordinance, No. 1 of 1898" (as amended in 1911), the annual statement of account and the calculation of interest due on investments are made up to the 30th of June in each year. The end of the financial year having now been advanced from June 30th to September 30th, an alteration would under ordinary circumstances be required in this Ordinance substituting September 30th for June 30th.

2. As a matter of fact, however, the books of the Fund are in practice kept with reference to the calendar year. It has been decided, therefore, by the Directors of the Fund that it would be more convenient if the annual statement of account and the annual calculation of interest were made up with reference to the same period.

3. The object of this Ordinance is to give effect to the decision of the Directors by making the necessary verbal alterations in sections 5 and 6 of the principal Ordinance.
