SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 1914.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha : fields are being sown in Hapitigam korale and Alutkuru Korale North, and in the other korales plants are thriving well. Yala : the paddy plants are thriving well.

Dry grain : kurakkan has been sown in Siyane Korale East and Hapitigam korale.

Other products : (a) fruits such as oranges, pineapples, mangoes, and jak fruits, are scarce ; (b) flowering and prospects of coconuts generally satisfactory.

Prices of staple products : (a) imported rice is sold from Rs. 4·50 to Rs. 8 per bushel ; (b) coconuts are sold from Rs. 25 to Rs. 35 per 1,000.

Rainfall : there were a few showers of rain during the month.

Harvest prospects : generally fair.

Health of inhabitants : generally good, excepting a few cases of smallpox in Colombo Mudaliyar's division, Hewagam Korale, and Siyane Korale East, and a few cases of measles and enteric fever in the Colombo Mudaliyar's division.

Health of cattle : rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease is prevailing in all the korales.

Health of cattle: satisfactory in Atakalan, Kukulu, and Kadawata korales. Rinderpest has appeared in some parts of Nawadun, Kuruwiti, and Meda korales.

Prices of food stuffs: rice (imported), Rs. 5 to Rs. 7.50 per bushel; rice (country), Rs. 5 to Rs. 6 per bushel; amu, 75 cents to Re. 1.75 per bushel; kurakkan, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2.50 per bushel; coconuts, Rs. 5 to Rs. 12 per 100; salt, 12 cents to 24 cents per measure.
