#### WESTERN PROVINCE.

##### COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Paddy : the maha cultivation is still going on in some villages.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products : fruits and vegetables were scarce, except in the totamunes, where there was a fair supply. The flowering of coconuts was good. The estimated crop of coconuts for the month was 2,594,500 nuts.

Prices of staple products : rice, Rs. 5 to Rs. 7·50 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 30 to Rs. 50 per 1,000 nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : nothing can be said at present of the coming harvest.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 13·77 in. ; daily average, 44 in.

Health of people : on the whole good.

Health of cattle : good.

#### CENTRAL PROVINCE.

##### KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation, maha : fields are in plants in Udunuwara ; being weeded and transplanted in Yatinuwara, Harispattu, Udapalata, and Uda Bulatgama ; being ploughed and sown in Pata Dumbara, Uda Dumbara, and Pata Hewaheta. Yala : being harvested in Tumpane, Harispattu, and Pata Hewaheta.

Dry grain cultivation, maha : chenas are being harvested in Tumpane ; being sown in Pata Dumbara and Uda Dumbara ; being cleared in Pata Hewaheta. There has been no cultivation in other divisions. Yala : chenas are being harvested in Pata Dumbara and Uda Bulatgama.

Rainfall : there has been sufficient rain during the month.

Prospect of coconut crop : flowering has been fair, except in Uda Dumbara. Estimated produce for October : Yatinuwara, 25,000 ; Tumpane, 14,000 ; Harispattu, 36,000 ; Pata Hewaheta, 285,000. Crop is not ascertained in other divisions. The price of coconuts has gone down.
