COLOMBO DISTRICT. [Report not received.]

#### KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy: the maha cultivation is still going on in some villages.

Dry grain: nothing worth reporting.

Other products: fruits and vegetables were scarce, except in the totamunes, where there was a fair supply. The flowering of coconuts was good. The estimated crop of coconuts for the month was 2,594,500 nuts.
