An undivided $\frac{1}{72}$ share of $\frac{3}{4}$ of the divided share of the land called Jasingegedarawatta *alias* Paranagedarawatta, at Polhena, and $\frac{1}{9}$ share of the tiled house of 9 cubits standing on the eastern side of the land, in extent the share of the accused is infinitesimal. The divided $\frac{3}{4}$ share is a little over 1 rood. The accused is entitled to only $\frac{1}{72}$ of this 1 rood.

The boundaries of the $\frac{3}{4}$ divided share (within which the $\frac{1}{72}$ undivided share is contained) is north Wadegewatta, Kattunnewatta ; east portion of the land Jasingegedarawatta ; south Gonduwawatta, Jambugahakoratuwa ; west Hakinawatta, Gajarigewatta, and Dehigahakoratuwa.

WHEREAS by proclamation dated October 20, 1914, and published in the *Gazette* No. 6,675 of October 23, 1914, the village of Dabarella, in East Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, was declared an infected area, under section 5 (1) and (2) of Ordinance No. 25 of 1909 ; and whereas foot-and-mouth disease has now ceased to exist in the said village : I hereby declare, under section 5 (5) of Ordinance No. 25 of 1909, that the said village of

Dabarella is free from foot-and-mouth disease, and is no longer an infected area.
