Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on September 1, 1911, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Ambegahahena, situate in the village of Godawela, in the Kiniyama korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 3 acres and 17 perches, and shown as lot 6C in preliminary plan 1,443, and in the annexed diagram, was made to Norman Albert Hampton, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 4,194):

And whereas Herat Mudiyanselage Guruhamy made claim thereto, and Howard Orme Fox, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim, and whereas the said claimant and the aforesaid Special Officer, Horward Orme Fox, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, came to an agreement in writing dated December 9, 1911, concerning the said land, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the said claimant should be declared the purchaser of the said land, upon payment on or before March 9, 1912, of a sum of Rupees Forty-eight only (Rs. 48), as the purchase amount of the said land, and whereas the said amount has been paid by the said claimant, he is hereby, in pursuance of the agreement afore-mentioned, declared to be the purchaser of the said land, as more fully described herein below.


