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FINAL ORDERS.

Kurunegala S. O. No. 869.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section [1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Timbirigahahena, situate in the village of Hendiyapola, in the Kiniyama korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of ." The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on October 25, 1912, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Timbirigahahena, situate in the village of Hendiyapola, in the Kiniyama korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 8 acres 2 roods and 16 perches, and shown as lot 9D in preliminary plan 1,438 and in the annexed diagram, was made to John Murray Davies, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 4,584):




